Frequently Asked Questions

Q1: Does Ultrasonic Affect Other Animals?

A1: It's not impacted other animals as long as they are out of 25 feet range. Household pets like cats and birds are not affected.

Q2: Will this hurt my other dogs who aren't reactive barkers?

A2: While it will not harm your other pets, this is a training device, so separating your already trained dogs from your reactive barker is advisable to avoid confusion. 25 feet is all that's required.

Q3: Why is Hawpet most effective with dogs age 6 months to 8 years?

A3: Age-related hearing loss makes it challenging for dogs over age 8 to hear and react. Before 6 months, a puppy's auditory system is not developed enough to fully understand the impact, so we err on the side of caution and recommend you only use it at 6 months or older.
