instructions

Power on: in the off state, press and hold the "touch surface" for 2S to directly conduct pairing mode, with red and blue flashing (red light for 0.5s, blue light for 0.5s)

Take out the power on / Auto pairing: take out the headset from the charging compartment, the headset will turn on automatically, and the left and right ears will pair automatically.

Power off: in the power on state, press and hold the "touch control surface" of the left and right ears for 5S, the red light will be on for 1 second and the light will be turned off, and there will be a "power off" prompt tone.

Automatic shutdown: automatic shutdown when there is no connection for 3 minutes or the battery is lower than 3.25V. Turn off the lights, and there is a "power off" tone. (or put it back into the charging box and shut down automatically)

Voice assistant: press and hold the "touch surface" for 3 seconds to enter the voice assistant single ear pairing mode: in the off state, press and hold the "touch surface" 3S to enter the pairing mode, "power on" + "pairing" prompt tone, and then the red and blue lights flash alternately. After the connection is successful, there is a "connected" prompt tone.

Automatic connection: after the Bluetooth headset is rebooted, it will automatically connect to the paired bluetooth enabled device, and there will be a prompt tone "connected".

Answering/hanging up/rejecting a call: To answer the call, tap the control panel 1 time. Hang up and reject the call, tap the control panel 2 times

Previous song: Double-click the left ear

Next song: Double-click the right ear

Automatic disconnection: keep the headset away from the phone and prompt "disconnected"

Play / pause: while playing music, tap the touch panel

Low power alarm: red light flash once in 1 second, prompt tone once in 70 seconds (alarm below 3.3V, shutdown below 3.2V) prompt tone "low power" (please charge)

Turn off the Bluetooth function of mobile phone: when the Bluetooth function is turned off, the headset will enter TWS pairing mode, and the device will be turned off after 6 minutes of searching

Display light means: charging display red light, full light off, turn on red and blue flashing alternately, pairing master Ear lights, connection does not flash

Indicator light of successful connection between headset and mobile phone: no flashing light on both ears

Bluetooth transmission distance (music status): > 10m

Precautions for use

1. The earphone should be stored in a dry and ventilated environment to avoid contact with oil, water vapor, steam and dust, so as to avoid affecting product performance.
2. If the headset is not connected or the communication is not smooth, please do not open the headset body and accessories without permission, otherwise it will not be guaranteed.
3. To charge the headset, please use the standard charger or the charger that meets the requirements.
4. In order to ensure the normal use of the headset, please make sure that the headset is fully charged.
