Note: Charge each speaker separately fully before using. (each speaker has its own charging port)

Charging the speakers:

- Switch off the speakers before charging.
- Plug the micro USB cable (supplied) into the speaker and connect the other end of the cable to a USB charging port.
- A red LED indicator will illuminate to indicate charging.

Once charging is complete, the red LED indicator will turn off.

Connect Via Bluetooth:

- Power on: Press and hold power buttons on both speakers simultaneously for 3 seconds, voice prompt from both speakers will say "power on", the BT device is ready to pair" and the blue LED indicator will flash.
- Turn on your mobile device and make sure the wireless function is activated.
- Search for "BT-Clear" on your device's bluetooth list and select it to pair.

The speaker will say "The BT device connected successfully" the LED indicator will illuminate.

- You can play music from your device and it will play through the speakers.
- Use the volume control on your device to adjust the volume.

- Power off: Press and hold power buttons on both speakers simultaneously for 3 seconds, voice prompt from both speaker will say "Power off "and the blue LED indicator will turn off.
