



## User Manual

Smart Pet Feeder









**Notice:**

- The feeder is for indoor household use only.
- The feeder can't support to connect to a power outlet, and it's not suitable to use the power adapter to connect to a power outlet.
- Please keep pets from biting the power cable or the power adapter.
- It may cause a leakage, short circuit, fire or other accidents if you damage the line to keep the food from spilling out if pets attacked over the equipment.

**Setup Instructions**

**Control panel:**

- Using the power adapter, plug the power adapter into the power outlet and turn on the power switch for 2 seconds to turn on the power.
- Press the power button (1.5 mesh) for 2 seconds to turn off the power.
- Press the feeding volume button to set the feeding volume.
- Press the feeding time button to set the feeding time.
- Press the feeding mode button to set the feeding mode.
- Press the feeding plan button to set the feeding plan.
- Press the feeding portion button to set the feeding portion.
- Press the feeding portion volume button to set the feeding portion volume.
- Press the feeding portion time button to set the feeding portion time.
- Press the feeding portion mode button to set the feeding portion mode.
- Press the feeding portion plan button to set the feeding portion plan.
- Press the feeding portion volume to 0 button to set the feeding portion volume to 0.
