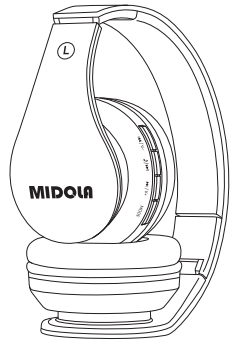
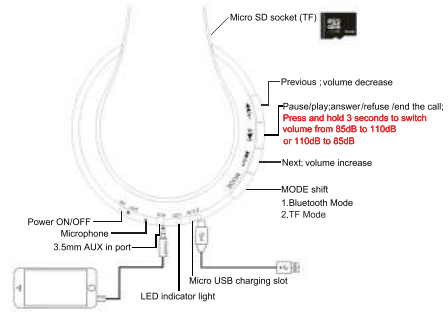

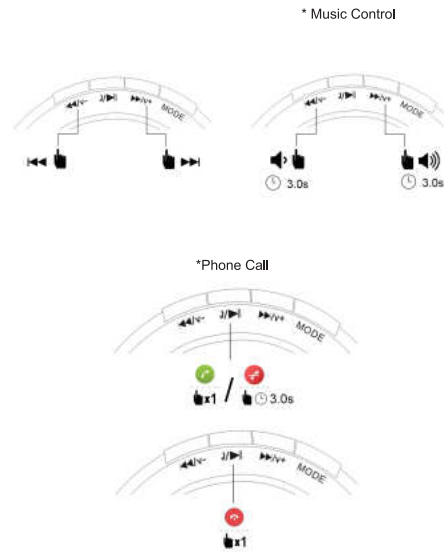

User Guide



Bluetooth

1. Pairing your device before the first use. To pair the headset with your mobile device, power on the headset and its Bluetooth mode is activated.
2. Connect to the mobile device



Micro SD(TF)

Power on the headset and insert Micro SD(TF) card into the TF socket

AUX Input

Insert the audio cable into AUX in port, insert the other end of the cable into the output of the player i.e. phone /computer, etc.

Attention: Do not insert the audio cable while power on. Or, the unit will be turned off.

Specifications

1. Bluetooth range: 10 meters
2. The battery capacity: 400 mAh
3. Input voltage: DC 5 V
4. Working voltage: 3.7 V
5. The standby time: 200 hours

1. When playing music intermittently or shutdown automatically, charge the device in time.
2. If you are not using for a long time, make sure to charge the device once a month for protecting the battery and extending the battery life.
