BLUETOOTH INSTRUCTIONS

Pair to a Bluetooth capable device for use. Follow the steps below to pair:

1. Open the Bluetooth Menu on the device you wish to pair. Some devices require you to select "Search for Devices" or "Add New Device" in order to create a Bluetooth Pairing
2. Starting with the headphones turned off, HOLD the power ON/OFF button. The headphones will say "PAIRING" The red and blue LED lights will flash an alternating pattern while in pairing mode.
3. Wait until you see "Kidz Bop Headphones" on your device screen.
4. Select "Kid Bop Headphones" and follow any further pairing prompts. Once pairing is complete and connection is established, LED lights will stay blue.

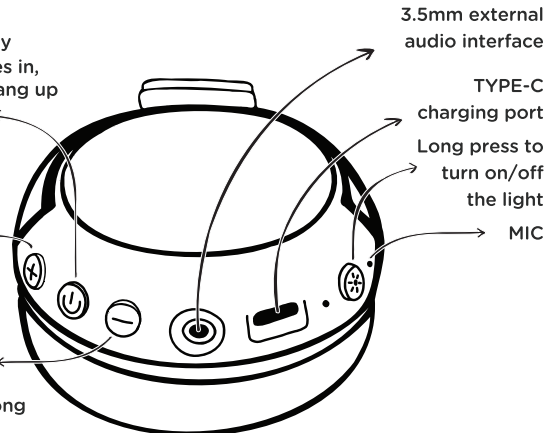
