Battery: Li-ion 18650 1200mAh, 3.7V

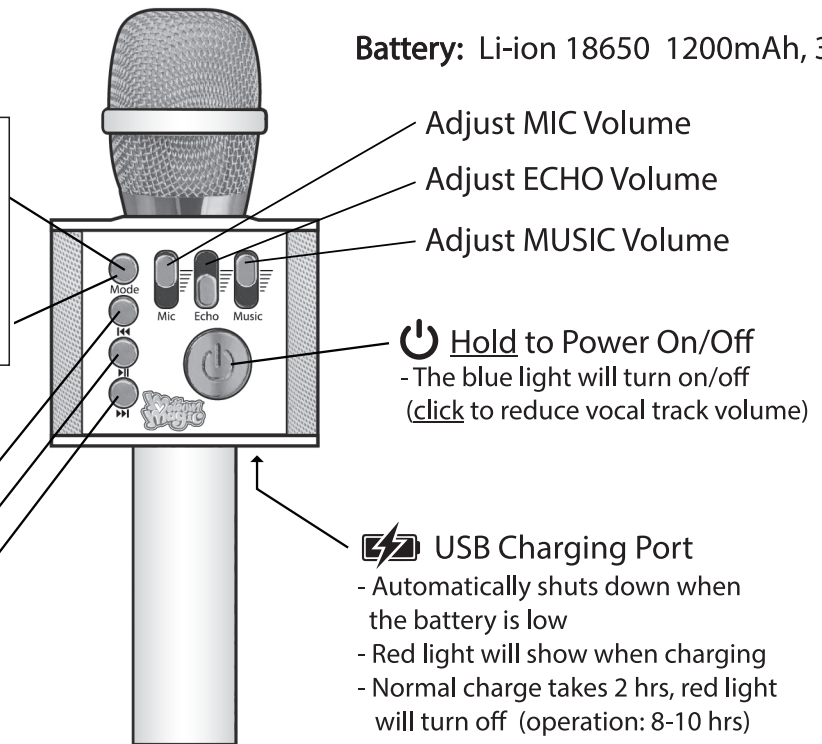
Bluetooth MODE:
