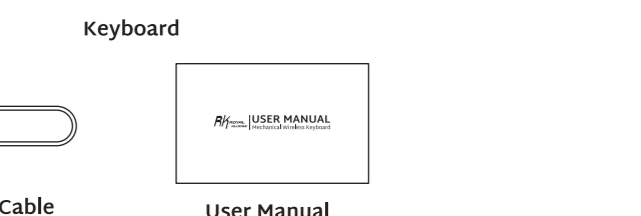
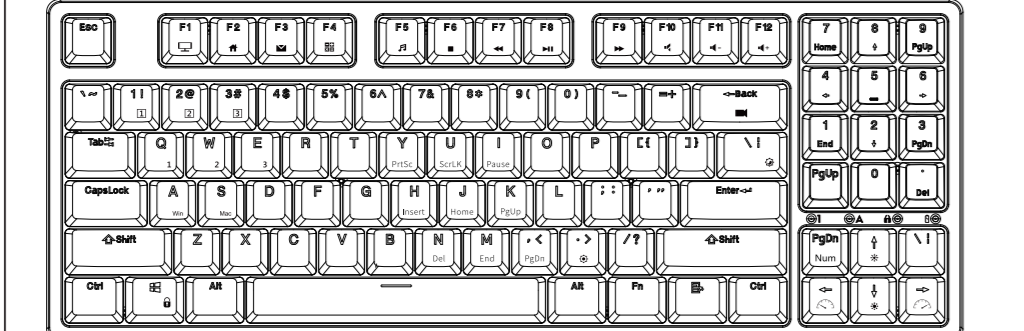

WIRED MODE & INDICATOR FUNCTION

Switch Power to OFF

left to right

- Fn+PgUp/Num
- Caps
- Fn+Fn/In Lock
- 1. Breathing state means charging
- 2. Fast flashing state means low battery
- 3. Steady light state means full charge

BATTERY REMINDER

Battery level reminder

Press and hold **Fn+Enter** to view the battery level indicator

for example:

- The backlight is bright, indicating that the keyboard is 10% of the power at this time
- The backlight is on at the same time, indicating that the keyboard is 20% of the power at this time
- The backlight is on at the same time, indicating that the keyboard power is 100% at this time

HOW TO USE

BT Connection

1. SHORT PRESS **Fn+Q/W/E** to BT Channel

2. LONG PRESS **Fn+Q/W/E** Entry Pairing Mode

BACKLIGHT CONTROL

COUSTOM BACKLIGHT SET

Step 1: Press **Fn + 11** to select a set of backlight mode.

Step 2: Press **Fn + Back** to enter the custom backlight settings (when the indicator lights start to blink).

Step 3: Press the keys that needs to set the backlight, repeat this step and complete other key backlight settings.

Step 4: Press **Fn + Back** again to save and exit.
