




BATTERY INSTALLATION




Swivel the latches on the bottom of the car and remove the battery pack.




Using a Phillips-head screwdriver, remove the screw by turning it counterclockwise and remove the battery cover from the


Insert 4 AA 1.5V batteries (not included) in the orientation shown.



Insert 2 AAA 1.5V batteries (not included) in the orientation shown.




Insert the battery pack and swivel the latches to secure it.




Replace the battery cover and screw by turning it clockwise.


MONSTER DRAG RACING




Slide the on/off switch on the remote and car to the I (on) position to turn on and pair.




Push both sticks forward to drive forward.



Push both joysticks backward to drive in reverse




Push one joystick forward and the other joystick backward to create a spinning vortex



Slide the on/off switch on the remote and car to the O (off position) to turn off.



Press and hold the action button to pop up into a wheelie while driving forward.



To race competitively against a friend's Monster Dragster, turn one remote on followed by the car it should pair with. Then turn on the other remote and car.



Try holding the action button while doing a spinning vortex to do more insane stunts!
