

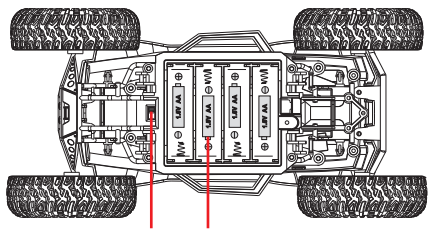
Thank you for purchasing the Vivitar RC Monster Truck, item VARC40081/VARC40080.

In order to get the best results, please read this user's manual carefully before using.

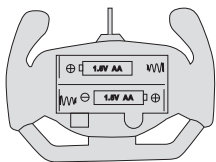
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### INSERTING/ REPLACING BATTERIES

1. Remove the screws securing the battery compartment cover on the underside of your Truck, and the battery compartment of the remote controller.
2. Insert 2 AA batteries (not included) into the battery compartment of the remote controller. Insert 4 AA batteries (not included) into the battery compartment of the Monster Truck.
3. Make sure to insert the batteries with the correct polarities (+, -) as indicated in the compartment.
4. Once batteries are inserted, place the cover back onto the compartments making sure they are securely closed.

### POWERING ON

Slide the ON/OFF Switch on both the remote controller (located at the front) and the Monster Truck (located next to the battery compartment) to the ON position to power them on. Slide them to the OFF position to power them off.

### SYNCHRONIZING THE REMOTE CONTROLLER WITH THE MONSTER TRUCK

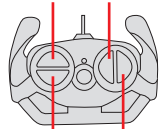
Once you power on both your Monster Truck and your remote control wait for a few moments as they synchronize to the same frequency.

Once synchronized, it is time to operate your vehicle!

### OPERATING YOUR MONSTER TRUCK

Press the up and down arrows to move your Monster Truck forward or backwards. Push the left and right buttons to turn your Monster Truck.
