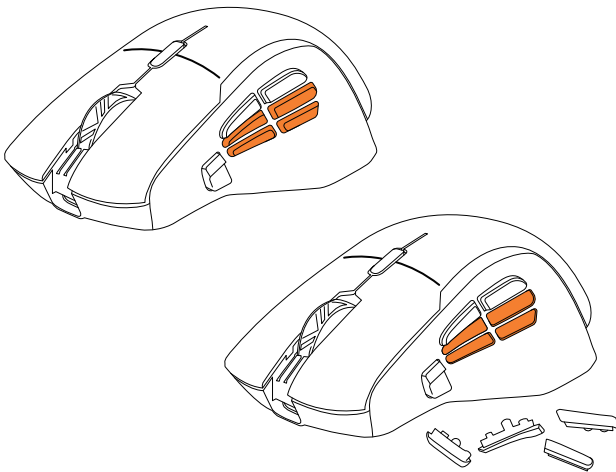

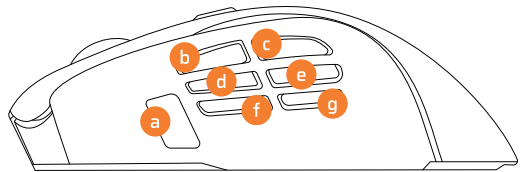

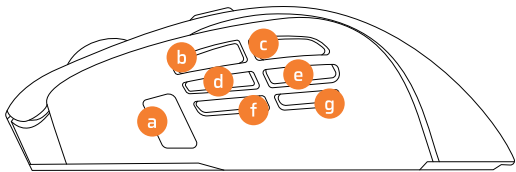

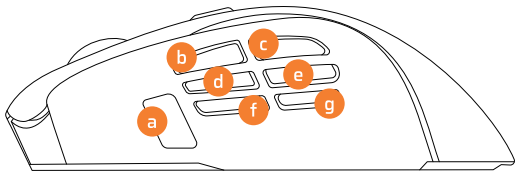

#### CONNECTING VIA 2.4GHZ WIRELESS

1. Connect the USB Dongle to an available USB Port on your device.
2. Toggle the Mode Switch to the "2.4G" position.
3. The Mouse and Dongle will pair automatically.
4. To further customize your Mouse, download the GearMaster Software from [Itcofficial.com/GearMaster](http://Itcofficial.com/GearMaster).

#### CONNECTING VIA BT

1. Toggle the Mode Switch to the "BT" position.
2. Press and hold the Left, Middle, and Right buttons at the same time until the DPI indicator light starts blinking.
3. Find your mouse in the list of available devices.
4. Click connect.
