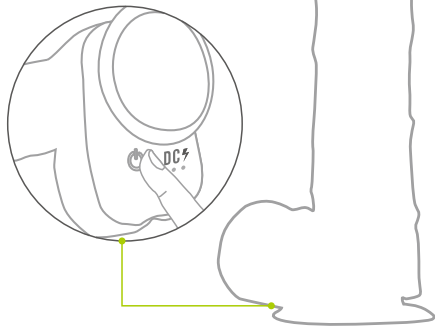


On/Off Button

3 types of speed)

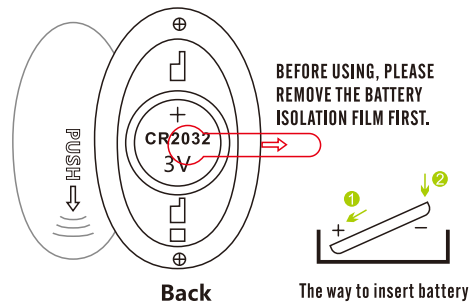
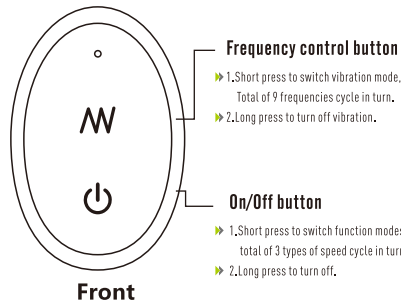

Instruction of Remote Control

NOTE: The remote control cannot turn on the product directly, it can only switch functions. When you use the product, please press the button on the base to turn on first.

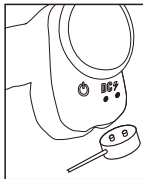


Functions:

- ⚡ 1. Please get the product charged before using.
- 🕒 2. **Step 1**---Press the button on the base of the product for 1.5 seconds, then the red light flashes, and it is in the standby state.
Step 2---Press the button on the remote to operate and switch the functions.
- 📶 3. Short press the button to switch the function modes, total of 9 frequencies with 3 speeds cycling.
- 🕒 4. Press the hold the on/off button for 1.5 seconds to turn off the product while the indicator light is off.

Charging Instruction:

- 1. Place the magnetic plug on the magnetic connector that on the base of the product, adjust the position if needed, until the indicator flashes it means under charging, and it is fully charged when the light stays on.
- 2. This product can not work when in charging.
- 3. It takes approx 90 minutes to get the product fully charged, and can be used for 50 minutes.



Tips:

- 1. It is recommended to use with lubricant together.
- 2. This product is for individual using only, please do not share with others for health concern; do not use alcohol, gasoline, acetone or other similar stuff for cleaning.
- 3. All products are tested from the factory, in case of low power, please charge immediately.
- 4. All the products are under strict inspection, it is normal for any tiny stains that may be caused during transportation.
- 5. It is for daily water resistant use only, can not be soaked in the water.
- 6. Please do not forcibly get this product jammed while in using.
- 7. Please do not disassemble the product which might cause short circuit, fire or an damage.

Cleaning, storage and safety instructions

- 1. This product is for adult only, please read the manual carefully before using.
- 2. This product should be stored in a cool and dry environment, and should not be exposure to any radiation or heat sources such as sunlight.
- 3. Do not put it together with any corrosive chemicals.
- 4. Check this device by times, and stop using if it is damaged.
- 5. It is for daily water resistant use only, just clean with water.
- 6. It needs to be cleaned before and after use.

Faults Clearing Guide

When this product comes to no working / can't be turned on / abnormal operation / extremely noisy or can't be charged, please follow the guides:

- 1. Please check if the product is under low power, and try again after charging for 15 minutes.
- 2. This product can not work while in charging, please take away the magnetic plug and try again.
- 3. Please check if the magnetic plug is well connected, adjust till indicator light flashes.
- 4. Please check if any filings or dust on the magnetic plug or connector.
- 5. Please try again with another charging power supply to charge.
