## Notes

1. Wireless charging function is not compatible with non-magnetic phones.

It is advisable not to wireless charge iPhone with a case on.

3. Do not use corrosive liquid to clean this product.

4. In case of accidental contact with chemicals, please wipe clean with a damp cloth.
