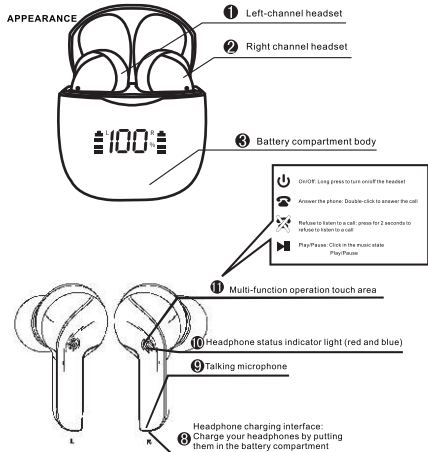
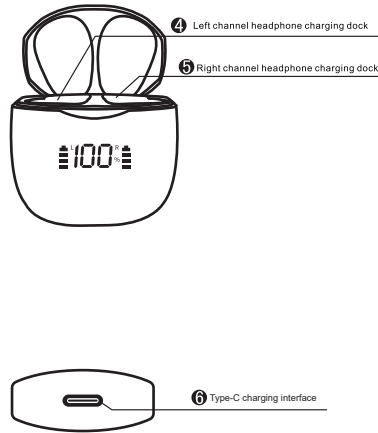


OPERATING INSTRUCTION A3 WIRELESS BLUETOOTH HEADSET

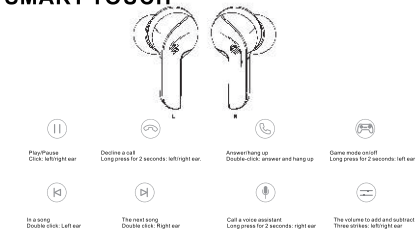
APPEARANCE



Note: for Android mobile phone system, when the volume of the mobile phone is increased to the maximum, if you want more volume, touch the left headphone three times in a row to increase the volume.

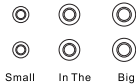

EAR CAP

The A3 headphones come in three sizes. Cap, please choose the right ear and the left ear Wear in full size (including the headphone book).The left earphone can only be worn by the left ear. The right earphone can only be worn by the right ear.



CONNECTION MATCHING

1. Open the charging compartment, take out the left and right earphones, and the left and right earphones will automatically start up and pair.
2. Initial pairing, turn on the phone Settings, access Bluetooth and turn on Bluetooth switch.
3. Search the Bluetooth device bar (A3) and click it to connect automatically.

THE HEADSET AUTOMATICALLY RECONNECTS AND PAIRS

After completing the first device pairing in accordance with the instructions, remove the headset from the charging bin and the headset will be self-loaded Move back to the Bluetooth device.

Note: If the headset was previously paired with more than one device, the headset will automatically reconnect to the last oneThe Bluetooth device used.

1. Open the top cover of the charging case and take out the earphone. The red and blue light of the left and right earphones flashes, followed by the blue light of the two earphonesBlink, left and right earphones pair successfully.
2. Open the charging compartment and take out the headset. The Red and blue lights of the left and right headphones flash alternately to show that the pair is not paired. double-click on the left and right earphone touch area twice (within 3 seconds of this action) and the paired pair will continue flashing.

FACTORY DATA RESET

When the left and right headphones do not combine to connect, or when one of the headphones does not play music, please perform the following Operation:

1. Put the left and right headphones into the charging case (they will enter the charging state).
2. Open the charging bin, take out the left and right earphones, automatically boot and pair, and reset successfully.
3. Open the interface of Bluetooth device, search for (A3) and click Connect.
4. Double-click the left and right earphone touch area twice at the same time (complete this action in 3 seconds) . The left and right earphone blue light flashes alternately.

CHARGING

EARPIECE

Put the left and right earphones back into the charging box, close the top cover of the charging box, and the left and right earphones will charge automatically.

CHARGING CASE CHARGING

When the charging box is charged, the charge box display will show the power, and when the charging bin is full, the display will show 100% power.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. If the sound quality is not good, please try to change the size and model of the earplugs: small, medium and large.
2. When you are in the subway, the airport, and other places with strong electromagnetic interference, the Bluetooth signal will be randomThere is a staccato in the concert. Because there are so many devices in the 2.4G wireless band, they tend to interfere with each other Cause. For some playback devices, audio and video will appear out of sync, TV and other non-mobile device performanceThis is mainly caused by the low Bluetooth version of these devices and their incompatibility.

3. If you encounter the following problems, please put the earphone into the charging box to turn it off, then take it out, the earphone will be heavyNew auto-boot pairing. If the problem still cannot be solved, please refer to the manual to restore the factory settingThe previously connected Bluetooth device (A3) has been deleted.

1. The left and right headphones don't match
2. The headset cannot be connected to the Bluetooth device
3. No sound from the left or right earphone
