

Operation Instructions


Key	Operation	Functions
 POWER	Short press	Short press "POWER" for 1.5s to turn the speaker on, and it enters the status that searches for Bluetooth by default when the key light is always-on.
	Long press	1. Under the power-on status, long press "POWER" for 2s to turn the speaker off; 2. In case of system halted, long press "POWER" for 8s to turn the speaker off coercively.
	Double click	1. Double click "POWER" to enter the dual pairing status; 2. Under the dual pairing connection status, double click "POWER" to disconnect dual pairing.
 V-/Prev	Short press	Short press "V-/PreV" to decrease the volume.
	Long press	Long press "V-/Prev" to switch to the previous song.
 PLAY/PAUSE	Short Press	1. Short press "PLAY/PAUSE" to stop playing under the Bluetooth/TF playing status; 2. Short press "PLAY/PAUSE" to play mutely under AUX playing status; 3. Short press "PLAY/PAUSE" to answer an incoming call; 4. Long press "PLAY/PAUSE" for 2s to reject an incoming call; Short press "PLAY/PAUSE" to hang up
	Long press	Long press "PLAY/PAUSE" for 3s to disconnect Bluetooth during Bluetooth connection status.
	Double click	Connect Bluetooth to headphones, and double click "PLAY/PAUSE" to recall the last phone number.

LED Indicators Instructions

1. After the speaker is powered on, the blue light flashes quickly during the status that searches for Bluetooth; the blue light is always-on after a successful Bluetooth connection;


2. The blue light flashes slowly during AUX audio playing or TF cardplaying; the blue light is always-on when it is paused;

3. The blue light is off when it is powered off or turned off coercively;


V+/Next

Short press

Short press "V+/Next" to increase volume.
Long press "V+/Next" to switch to the next song.


MODE

Short press
Double click
Long Press

Short press "MODE" to switch modes such as BT, TF andAUX (the one that is plugged later gains priority).
Open/close RGB light/switch light effect mode.
Long Press "Mode" to restore factory settings and clear all previous operating memories.

Bluetooth Pairing

1. The speaker will automatically enter the status that searches for Bluetooth when it is powered on, and the blue light flashes quickly;

2. Open and search for Bluetooth that requires a connection to the device,then connect to "Musibaby M33". After a successful connection, the bluelight is always-on and it starts to play music;

3. If it fails to play music, please power off and restart the speaker (such issue may be caused by the low battery). If there isn't any operation during10mins, the speaker will automatically turn off. It won't power off under Bluetooth connection status.

AUX/TF Card Playing Mode

1. Insert the equipped audio cable into the AUX audio input port, and the device will automatically play all music stored in the TF card; The blue light flashes slowly during playing, and the blue light is always-on when it is paused.

2. Insert TF card (up to 32GB) and the device will automatically play all music stored in the TF card;

Dual Pairing

1. Power on two speakers (in case of other Bluetooth connections, please disconnect them and make your speakers in the Bluetooth searching status);

2. Double click the "POWER" (one of speaker) to enter the Dual Pairing mode. At this time, the green light flashes and it has beep to prompt;
