


POWER SUPPLY

BATTERY OPERATION

- OPEN THE BATTERY DOOR AND INSERT 6 PCS "C-CELL" (UM-2/LR14 TYPE) BATTERIES. PLEASE OBSERVE CORRECT BATTERY POLARITIES OR THE SET WILL NOT WORK.

- IMPORTANT: WHEN THE SET IS ONLY USED WITH "AC", OR IS NOT USED FOR 4 WEEKS OR MORE, PLEASE REMOVE THE BATTERIES, TO AVOID DAMAGE TO THE SET FROM LEAKAGE OF BATTERIES.



AC OPERATION (BUILT-IN AC TRANSFORMER)

- MAKE SURE THE VOLTAGE SETTING OF THE PRODUCT MATCHES YOUR LOCAL HOUSEHOLD VOLTAGE. - INSERT THE CONNECTOR OF THE AC-CORD INTO THE AC SOCKET AT THE REAR OF THE PRODUCT. - INSERT THE PLUG OF THE AC-CORD INTO A WALL OUTLET WITH AC-POWER.

IMPORTANT!

PLEASE MAKE SURE TO SET THE FUNCTION SWITCH TO "OFF" POSITION WHEN UNIT IS NOT IN USE TO CONSERVE POWER.

OPERATION OF RADIO

- SET THE FUNCTION SWITCH TO THE "FM" POSITION

- ROTATE TUNING KNOB TO TUNE-IN THE DESIRED FM STATION.

- ADJUST THE PHYSICAL POSITION AND ORIENTATION OF THE PRODUCT TO OBTAIN THE BEST RECEPTION. - ADJUST THE VOLUME KNOB TO THE DESIRED LEVEL.

- TO TURN OFF THE RADIO, SLIDE THE FUNCTION SWITCH TO "OFF".

INSERTION & REMOVAL OF DISCS

- WHEN OPENING THE CD-DOOR, ALWAYS ENSURE THE DISC IS NOT IN MOTION (NOT SPINNING). ALWAYS PRESS "STOP" KEY TO STOP THE DISC SPINNING FIRST.

- PLACE A CD DISC INTO THE COMPARTMENT WITH THE LABEL-SIDE (PRINTED SIDE) FACING UPWARDS. PRESS DOWN IN THE CENTER PART OF DISC UNTIL THE IT "LOCKS" ONTO THE CENTER SPINDLE.
- GENTLY LOWER THE CD-DOOR DOWNWARDS UNTIL IT IC COMPLETELY SHUT.
- THE CD IS NOW READY TO BE PLAYED.
- TO REMOVE A DISC, LIFT THE CD DOOR UPWARDS AND REMOVE THE DISC BY PLACING ONE FINGER AT THE MIDDLE OF CD (AT CENTER SPINDLE) & THE OTHER FINGER AT THE EDGE OF THE DISC AND THEN GENTLY PULLING UPWARDS.

- IMPORTANT : ALWAYS HOLD A CD BY ITS EDGES. AVOID GETTING ANY FINGER PRINTS, SMUDGES OR DIRT ONTO THE SURFACE OF A DISC. IN CASE THIS HAPPENS, USE A SPECIAL CD-CLEANING CLOTH OR CLEANING KIT TOREMOVE THE DIRT OR SMUDGES.

CD PLAYER OPERATION

- INSERT A CD DISC AS DESCRIBED.

- SLIDE THE FUNCTION SWITCH TO "CD/AUX", THE DISPLAY SHOWS "CD". - THE CD WILL SPIN MOMENTARILY AND THEN THE DISPLAY WILL SHOW THE
- TOTAL NUMBER OF TRACKS (SONGS) ON THE DISC.

- PRESS THE 🕨 KEY TO START PLAYBACK.

- AT ANYTIME DURING PLAYBACK, PRESS THE **I** KEY TO PAUSE OPERATION OF THE UNIT. PRESS THE **I** KEY TO RESUME OPERATION AT THE SAME TRACK & POSITION.
- AT ANYTIME DURING PLAYBACK, PRESS THE **E**KEY TO STOP PLAYBACK. THIS WILL RESET THE CD-PLAYER TO THE FIRST TRACK.
- AT ANYTIME DURING PLAYBACK, "PRESS AND RELEASE" THE 🗺 OR 📂 KEYS TO SKIP BACKWARDS OR FORWARDS BY ONE TRACK, AS DESIRED.

USB MP3 PLAYBACK

- INSERT A USB PENDRIVE (FLASH MEMORY) INTO THE USB SOCKET.

- SLIDE THE FUNCTION SWITCH TO "BT/USB".

 PRESS THE ■ KEY FOR 3 SECONDS THEN RELEASE, THE DISPLAY SHOWS "USB" MOMENTARILY AND THEN SHOWS THE TOTAL NUMBER OF TRACKS ON THE USB DRIVE.
PRESS THE ■ KEY TO START PLAYING. THE DISPLAY WILL INDICATE THE CURRENT TRACK NUMBER. IF THE MP3 SONGS ARE STORED IN SEVERAL "FOLDERS" ON THE USB DRIVE, THE DISPLAY WILL ALTERNATELY SHOW WHICH FOLDER THE CURRENT SONG IS SAVED IN (INDICATED BY "F" FOLLOWED BY THE FOLDER NUMBER eg. F01).
AT ANY TIME DURING PLAYBACK, PRESS AND RELEASE I OF TO SKIP BACKWARDS OR FORWARDS BY ONE TRACK.

"PRESS AND HOLD" THE IMI OR IMI KEYS TO FAST-REVERSE (REVIEW) OR FAST-FORWARD (CUE) THE SPECIFIC TRACK, WHICH IS CURRENTLY PLAYING.

BLUETOOTH MODE

- SLIDE THE MODE SWITCH TO THE BT/USB POSITION.

- THE DISPLAY WILL SHOW "bt"

- TURN ON THE BLUETOOTH FUNCTION ON YOUR MOBILE DEVICE, SEARCH AND SELECT "TYLER TAU107"

- WHEN THE MOBILE PHONE IS PAIRED TO THE BOOMBOX, THERE WILL BE AN AUDIO NOTIFICATION TO CONFIRM THE DEVICES ARE CONNECTED.

- ONCE PAIRED, THESE 2 DEVICES WILL AUTOMATICALLY RE-CONNECT IN FUTURE - WHEN YOU TURN OFF THE BLUETOOTH FUNCTION ON YOUR DEVICE, OR SWITCH THE BOOMBOX TO A DIFFERENT SOURCE (eg. CD or USB) THERE WILL BE AN AUDIO NOTIFICATION TO CONFIRM THE DEVICES ARE DISCONNECTED.

IMPORTANT - MP3 FILE NAME FORMAT

PLEASE TAKE CARE TO USE ONLY REGULAR ENGLISH ALPHABETS (A TO Z) & NUMERALS (0 TO 9) IN THE FILE NAMES OF MP3 SONGS. CHARACTERS SUCH AS "_" (UNDERSCORE) & " " (SPACE) MAY RESULT IN THE FILES BEING UNREADABLE OR INCONSISTENTLY UNRECOGNIZABLE BY THE PLAYER.

NOTE:

THIS PRODUCT IS FULLY COMPATIBLE WITH USB 1.1 & 2.0 STANDARDS. HOWEVER, A SMALL PERCENTAGE OF USB FLASH DRIVES MIGHT NOT BE READABLE, DUE TO SOME USB-DRIVES BEING NON-COMPLIANT WITH THE FULL (OFFICIAL) USB 1.1 / 2.0 STANDARDS.

REMOVAL OF USB DRIVES

NEVER REMOVE (OR UNPLUG) USB-DRIVES FROM THE SET DURING PLAYBACK OF MP3 SONGS FROM THESE MEDIA. ALWAYS PRESS (STOP) FIRST BEFORE REMOVING OR UNPLUGGING USB MEMORY, TO PREVENT DAMAGE TO YOUR SONG FILES OR MEMORY DEVICES.

IMPORTANT

Please do NOT use a USB Extension Cable to connect your USB FLASH DRIVE to the USB PORT of this unit.

Such cables can pick up interference which can corrupt the data flow, preventing normal operation and usage of the USB port.

Always connect your USB Flash Drive DIRECTLY to the USB PORT without any USB extension cables.

REPEAT PLAYBACK FUNCTION AT ANYTIME DURING PLAYBACK, PRESS THE "REPEAT" KEY PRESS ONCE: TO REPEAT THE CURRENT TRACK ONLY DISPLAY SHOWS A FLASHING "REPEAT" SYMBOL: PRESS TWICE: TO REPEAT ALL TRACKS DISPLAY SHOWS A SOLID "REPEAT" SYMBOL: PRESS THREE TIMES:: TO CANCEL THE REPEAT FUNCTION	USING THE AUDIO LINE IN CONNECTION (AUX-INPUT) - YOU CAN CONNECT THE AUDIO OUTPUT OF AN EXTERNAL DEVICE SUCH AS A MOBILE PHONE TO THIS UNIT, TO LISTEN TO THE SOUND OF THAT DEVICE THROUGH THE AMPLIFIER AND SPEAKERS OF THIS BOOMBOX. - TO CONNECT AN EXTERNAL AUDIO DEVICE, PLEASE USE A STANDARD STEREO CABLE (NOT INCLUDED) WITH 3.5MM PLUGS TO CONNECT THE "HEADPHONE-OUT OR AUDIO LINE-OUT" OF THE EXTERNAL DEVICE TO THE AUX-INPUT SOCKET OF THIS UNIT. - SLIDE THE FUNCTION SWITCH TO "CD/AUX", - SWITCH ON THE EXTERNAL DEVICE, START MUSIC PLAYBACK AND ADJUST VOLUME CONTROL OF THE EXTERNAL DEVICE, AND THE BOOMBOX TO THE DESIRED LEVEL. - REMEMBER TO SWITCH OFF THE POWER OF THE BOOMBOX WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED USING THE EXTERNAL DEVICE.
PROGRAMMING THE CD-PLAYER - THE CD PLAYER CAN BE PROGRAMMED TO PLAY ANY SEQUENCE OF UPTO 20 TRACKS AS DESIRED. - ALWAYS PRESS THE STOP ■ KEY BEFORE STARTING THE PROGRAMMING. - PRESS ■ THE KEY, THE DISPLAY WILL SHOW A ● SYMBOL (FLASH) AND THE DISPLAY WILL SHOW " P01 ", TO INDICATE THAT THE SET IS NOW IN "PROGRAMMING MODE", AT MEMORY POSITION NO. 1. - PRESS THE I ● OR ● KEY TO SELECT THE TRACK (SONG) NUMBER YOU WISH TO BE STORED IN THE FIRST MEMORY (PROGRAM) POSITION, AND PRESS THE PROGRAM KEY TO CONFIRM YOUR SELECTION. - WHEN YOU PRESS ● KEY THE DISPLAY WILL ADVANCE TO THE NEXT MEMORY POSITION NUMBER (EG. " P02 "FOR 2ND POSITION). - REPEAT THE PROGRAM KEY TO CONFIRM YOUR SELECTING ANY SONG NUMBER OF YOUR CHOICE TO BE STORED IN THE SUCCESSIVE MEMORY (PROGRAM) POSITIONS. - AFTER EACH SONG (TRACK) NUMBER, REMEMBER TO PRESS THE PROGRAM KEY ● - AFTER A MAXIMUM OF SONGS (OR LESS) HAVE BEEN SELECTED AS DESCRIBED ABOVE, PRESS THE PROGRAM KEY. ● - PRESSING ● WILL NOW PLAY BACK THE "SAVED SEQUENCE" IN THE PROGRAM MEMORY. - ALSO, THE ● YYMBOL WILL REMAIN "ON" TO INDICATE THAT YOU HAVE SAVED A PROGRAM-MEMORY (SEQUENCE). - PRESSING ● SYMBOL WILL REMAIN "ON" TO INDICATE THAT YOU HAVE SAVED A PROGRAM-MEMORY (SEQUENCE). - PRESSING ● OR ● KEY WILL MOVE TO THE NEXT OR PREVIOUS SONG IN THE SAVED SEQUENCE. - TO CLEAR (CANCEL) THE ENTIRE PROGRAM WHICH IS STORED IN THE MEMORY, SIMPLY PRESS "STOPP ● TWICE (● SYMBOL WILL DISAPPEAR), OR SWITCH "OFF" THE SET.
