1. CAUTIONS

- This product is only used for igniting fireworks. The user must use this product according to the local laws and regulations.
- Please keep the power off when you are connecting the fireworks.
- Please keep away from the fireworks when you are igniting them.
- It is low voltage alarm while the Power LED blinks, please replace the battery.

- Modes: Single Fire



4. Instructions



- Learn code of the remote controller: Turn the Function Switch of the receiver to "Single", "Seq.0+" or "Seq.1+". Keep pressing the Learn Button until the Status LED lights, press the button of the remote controller within 3 seconds, the Status LED blinks.
- > Turn the Group Switch to "G1".
- > The sequence number of the receiver is according to the learned number of the remote controller.
- Keep the power off, and connect the fireworks.
- > Turn the Function Switch to "Test". If the Test LED lights, the fireworks is connecting well. Otherwise, it is not connected or it is bad.
- ➤ Turn the Function Switch to "Single", "Seq.0+" or "Seq.1+", keep away from the fireworks, then press the button of the remote controller, the receiver will ignite the fireworks, and the Fire LED lights at the same time.

5. Mode

Single Fire: Turn the Function Switch to "Single", press the button of the remote controller which the receiver has learned the code, and the receiver will be fired.
