## SETUP

Before playing with your controller please make sure your Switch® is updated with latest version.

#### SWITCH

## Connect via Bluetooth®

1. Turn on system and enter the "Home" screen, select the "Controller" settings

LEDs flash quickly in order, this means it is activating pairing mode".

- 2. Go to "Change Grip/Order"
- 3. Press and hold the controller back Bluetooth® pairing button for 3 seconds until controller  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{B}}$
- 4. Controller will connect to system automatically, press "L/R" at the same time to finish pairing.

#### CONNECT VIA CABLE

- 1. Connect your system with the included USB–C cable and your system will automatically connect.
- 2. Disconnect USB-C and the corresponding LED will turn on.

#### HOW TO RECONNECT

- 1. Press "Home" button on your controller to awaken the system and the system enters pairing mode, four LEDs will flash quickly in order.
- Controller will connect to Switch automatically, the corresponding LED will keep light (the controller enters sleep mode if failed to connect within 10 minutes)

#### AUTO WAKE-UP SYSTEM

- When system is in stand-by status, press controller "Home" button. The controller will awake system automatically, the corresponding LED will light.
- 2. System screen turns off– controller will also enter sleeping mode, press "Home" button to awaken controller.
- 3. Controller will automatically enter sleeping mode if there is no operation after 5 minutes.

\*Press and hold "Home" button for more than 2 seconds to call out system "Sleep" window.

\*Press the Bluetooth "pairing/reset" button to shut down controller and disconnect with system

## SETUP

### LED CHARGING INDICATOR

- 1. When charging, LED1-LED4 will slowly flash when charging, 4 LEDs will turn off when fully charged.
- 2. When controller connects with system and charging, the corresponding LEDs will keep lighting.
- 3. When the power is low the corresponding LED flashes quickly
- 4. When re-connecting and charging at the same time, the re-connection LED indicator will get priority showing the connection status.




