Quick Reference

Volume Up/Down
Click – 1 Step change
Hold – Quick charge

Group
Click – Roll call
2x Click – Leave group
3x Click – Toggle modes
Hold – Create/Join group

Power
Click – Battery info
Hold – Power on/off

Hard Reset
While powered off, hold BT button + Power button until startup buzz is felt. Release.

Milo
Click – Mic mute/unmute
Hold – Open mic while in manual mode

Bluetooth
Click – Pair with a BT headset in pairing mode

Success Tips

Bluetooth Pairing
To pair with a supported Bluetooth headset, refer to the pairing instructions for that headset.
Initiate pairing on the headset before you click the Milo Bluetooth button.

Unit Temperature
If a unit gets very warm to the touch, power it off and give it time to cool before charging again. The charger automatically stops charging if the unit reaches a high temperature.

Hard Reset
If your Milo behaves unexpectedly, cycle the power or do a hard reset. If the issue persists, refer to Troubleshooting in the Milo app.

Wearing Milo
Milo securely clips into its armband or pocket clip, and the back is magnetic. Choose an accessory that keeps your Milo close and unobstructed.

Quick Start

Step 1
Press the power button to power up.
Milo greets you with its pre-assigned name.

Step 2
Hold the group button on each Milo to group.

Step 3
Milo's mic is muted at startup. Click Milo button to unmute/mute.

Connecting with Others

Create or Join a Group
Hold the side button. A chime and LEDs tell you grouping is in progress. Release the button after you hear "Connected".

Leave a Group
To leave a group, double-click the side button. When asked to confirm, double-click again. If you're in a group, you need to leave it to join another.

Staying in Contact

Group Information
Get up-to-date group member info with a group button click.

Location Updates
Milo keeps the group informed when distance between Milo's grows... and reconnects automatically when back in range.

Power & Battery

Battery Life
Click the power button for battery charge info. To power down, hold the power button (2-3s).

Charging
Use a USB-C cable to charge, even from a portable power source while on-the-go.
