





- 配对状态:左右耳机开机,配对成功后,主副耳随机分配
- 耳机与手机配对:从充电仓拿出耳机,耳机自动开机,进入配对与回连状态,打 开手机蓝牙并在蓝牙列表中找到设备名,连接设备。
- 回连状态:打开充电仓取出耳机自动回连

1.Headphone MFB key

• Start up; start up manually, and press MFB for about 3 seconds: Start the machine automatically, pick up the headset from the charging chamber, the White blue lamplight of the main ear flashes, and the light of the auxiliary ear does not light up.




• Shutdown; manual shutdown, long press the MFB button of the left or right headset for about 5 seconds, and the white light will flash for 3 times and then go out Lamp; Automatic shutdown, automatic shutdown after putting the headset into the charging chamber (when the charging chamber is powered on), white light On; After power on or disconnection of Bluetooth connection, if there is no operation, it will automatically shut down and turn off the light in about 5 minutes.

- Pairing status: the left and right earphones are powered on, and after successful pairing. the main and auxiliary ears are randomly assigned
- Headset pairing with mobile phone: take out the headset from the charging compartment, and the headset will automatically power on, enter pairing and reconnection status, open the mobile phone Bluetooth, find the device name in the Bluetooth list, and connect the device.
- Return connection status; open the charging compartment, take out the headset and automatically return it
- Play/pause; When the headset playing music, click the left or right ear to play/pause music • Volume+: When playing music through headphones, triple tap the MFB button on the left ear to increase the volume,
- Volume-: When playing music through headphones, three clicks on the MFB button on the right ear can reduce the volume • Previous song; when the headset is playing music, click the left ear MFB key three times
- to switch to the previous song Next song: when the headset is playing music, click the right ear MFB key three times to switch to the next song
- Incoming call answering: click the MFB button on the left or right ear to answer an incoming call
- . Hang up the phone; after the call is completed, double click the MFB button on the left or right ear to end the call
- Refuse to answer: When a call is received, long press the MFB key on the left or right ear for 2S to reject the call
- Start SIRI/voice assistant; when connected to standby or music playing/pausing status, long press MFB key of left ear or right ear for 2 seconds to start voice assistant
- Single ear use; Click; Play/Pause/Answer/End Double click; Next track, Three strikes; Increase the volume, Long press: Voice Assistant/Reject
- . Charging; put the headset into the charging box to charge the headset. The white light of the headset is always on during charging, and the white light of the fully charged

Bluetooth pairing

1. Open the charging compartment, take out the headset and start it automatically; Please keep the distance between the Bluetooth headset and the mobile phone (or other connecting devices) within 50CM, the closer the better.





2. Open the Bluetooth interface of the mobile phone, search for "sanag Z31S Pro Max*, click pairing, and connect the device.
