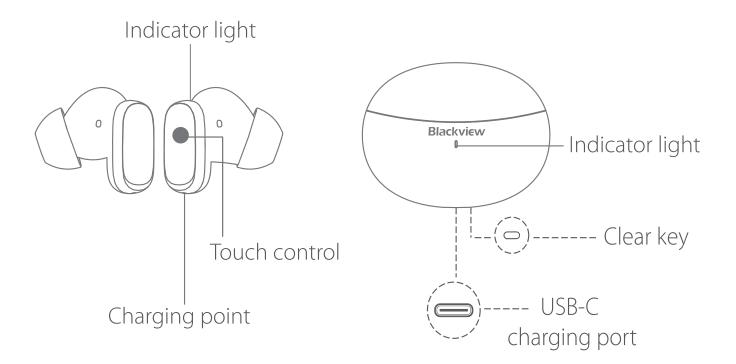

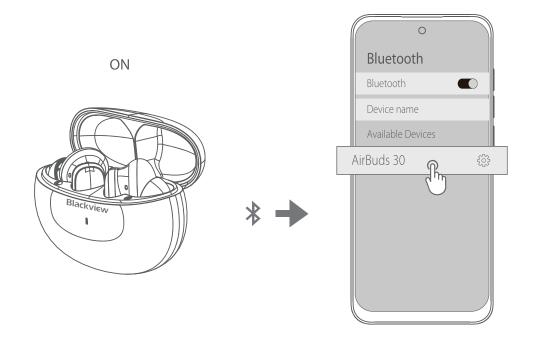

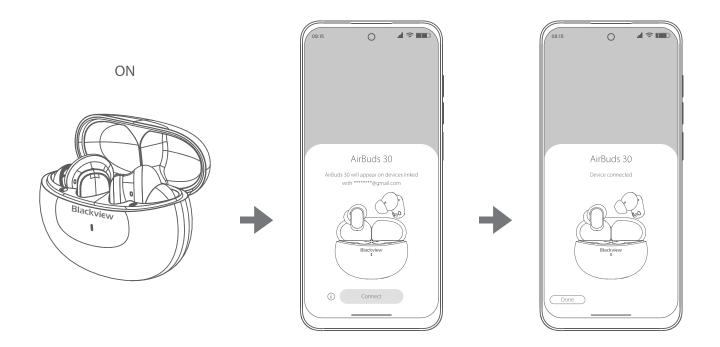
PRODUCT INTRODUCTION



Connect



- 1. Open the lid(Earbuds auto power on).
- 2. After open the phone Bluetooth, Click the [AirBuds 30] to Pairing.

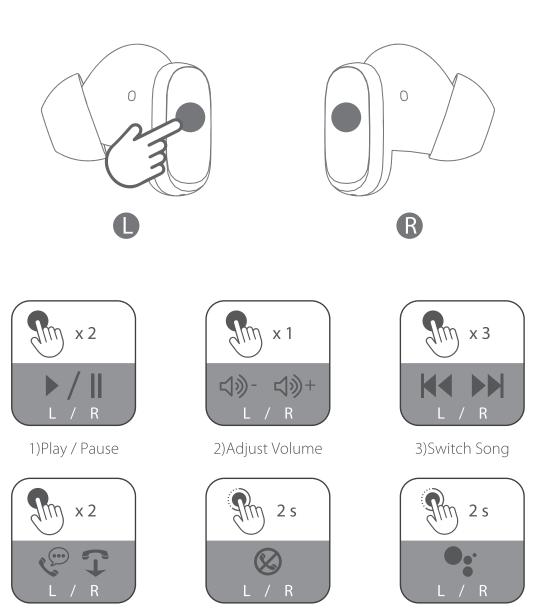


- 1. When the [AirBuds 30] is in the charging case, keep the cover open.
- 2. Then press and hold the Clear key on the bottom of the charging case for about 3 seconds, or until the status indicator light of the charging case flashes green.
- 3. After the pop-up appears on your phone, press "Connect". Displays "Device connected" when connection is successful.

Reset

- 1. Delete the pairing data on your phone for the [AirBuds 30].
- 2. Put the earphones back into the charging case and open the cover.
- 3. Press and hold the Clear key on the bottom of the charging case for about 10 seconds, or until the status indicator light of the charging case flashes orange.
- 4. Close the cover to start charging the earphones and wait 20 seconds.
- 5. Open the cover and take out the earphones.
