Quick Installation

The following practices may only be operated with power off:
Dismantling the upper cover of main unit (as shown in the figure)
1. Unscrewing with a screwdriver.
2. Take out by pushing the upper cover of main unit.

Installation of SSD card (as shown in the figure)
1. Align the groove on SSD with the bevel of MC side on the interface.

Installation of hard disk (as shown in the figure)
1. Secure the hard disk to the bracket. Align the screws, organize the SATA terminal wire, install the hard disk in the bottom case, and tighten the screws.

Tips and FAQ

1. Turn on your Mini PC.
2. If your Mini PC does not respond after the power button is set, please check if the power cable is normal.
3. When you turn on your device for the first time, you will be guided to complete the initial setup process.
4. Set up your Mini PC for the first time.
5. When you turn on your device for the first time, you will be guided to complete the initial setup process.
6. Step 1: Select language/country (English).
7. Step 2: Select the second inputting method, which can be "Keyboard" or "Handwriting".
8. Step 3: Select the second inputting method, which can be "Keyboard" or "Handwriting".
Or choose to plug network cable for connection. (Networking will be available after connection.)
