

User Manual

Product function instruction



- 1 "V" Volume up/Next song
- 2 Power on/Off/Music play/pause
- 3 "V" Volume down/Previous song
- 4 Bluetooth indicator/charging indicator/ANC indicator
- 5 Sleep mode
- 6 Type-C charging port
- 7 Microphone
- 8 ANC switch


Power on/off

Power on: Press and hold "2" about 3 second until the red and blue indicator blinks alternately,it will be pairing status.

Power off: Press and hold "8" about 3 seconds,the red indicator will be on around 1 seconds and goes off.

Paring

When pairing the product name " ANC918 " on the list,click to connect the headset with your device,once paired successfully,the blue indicator blinks every 6 seconds.



Music play

Volume up: Click the "1" button to increase volume

Volume down: Click the "3" button to decrease volume

Fast song: Press and hold the "1" button around 2 second

Previous song: Press and hold the "3" button around 2 second

Music play/pause: Click the "2" button

Calling (Mobile)

Answer call: Click the "2" button when call is coming

End call: Click the "2" button when call is over

Cancel call: Click the "2" button when calling

Reject call: Press and hold the "2" button around 2 seconds when call is coming

Redial: Click the "2" button to redial last call number


Reset

Press and hold the "1" and "3" button at the same time around 2 seconds until the red and blue indicator flash alternately.

Siri or google assistant

In standby mode or music mode, tap twice the "2" button

ANC on/off



Turn on: When the ANC function is off, turn the ANC switch on then the ANC indicator will be on.

Turn off: When the ANC function is enabled, turn the ANC switch off then the ANC indicator will be off.

Bluetooth indicator instruction

Connect successfully	The blue indicator blinks every 6 seconds
Pairing status	The red and blue indicator blink alternately
Standby	The red and blue indicator blink alternately
Volume Up/Next	The blue indicator blinks every 6 seconds
Volume Down/Previous	The blue indicator blinks every 6 seconds
Play/Pause	The blue indicator blinks every 6 seconds
Power Off	The red indicator will be on around 1 second then goes off
Charging	The indicator will be solid red

AUX mode

Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable into the audio jack of the headset; Connect the other end into your mobile or other device,then can play music.


Note: The headphones will be powered off once plug the 3.5mm audio cable into audio jack,When headphones is power on,plug 3.5mm audio cable must be taken out from the headphones if need to turn on the headphones.

Charging instruction

Before using,please check and assure the battery is enough.

While the headphones is low battery,please use Type-C charging cable to charge and the charging indicator will be red when charging. Once it fully charged,the indicator will be off.

The headphones will be turned off automatically when charging. It will take about 2 hours to charge fully.

FAQ

Q1:Why can't I connect it?

A:Please ensure the battery is enough.

Q2:Whying before?

A:Please ensure the headphones is in power-on and pairing status, and the mobile or other device is close within 10 m range; And then re-attempt.

Q3:Connect automatically.

A:The headphones will automatically connect the mobile or other devices which it used last time.

Q4:Sound not off/switch.

A:Check whether the mobile or other devices is also out of range (10m) and whether there are obstacles between the headphones and mobile.

Q5:Charging is slow.

A:Please ensure the charging adapter is DC 5V/1A or Car charger or powerbank to charge the headphones.

Q6:How to reduce the noise during the use?

A:Increase the separation between the equipment and receiver.

Q7:Connect the equipment into an radio on a actual distance than that to which the receiver is connected.

Q8:Connect the radio or an experienced radio / TV technician for help.

Q9:Radiation Exposure Statement.
