






4. CONDUCTED SPURIOUS & BAND EDGE EMISSION

4.1 LIMIT

According to FCC section 15.247(d), in any 100kHz bandwidth outside the frequency band in which the spread spectrum or digitally modulated intentional radiator is operating, the radio frequency power that is produced by the intentional radiator shall be at least 20dB below that in the 100kHz bandwidth within the band that contains the highest level of the desired power, based on either an RF conducted or a radiated measurement.



Tune the measurement with the spectrum analyzer's resolution bandwidth (RBW) = 100 kHz. In order to make an accurate measurement, the span is set to be greater than RBW.





6.2 TEST PROCEDURE

- a. The transmitter output (antenna port) was connected to the spectrum analyzer.
- b. Set RBW =1MHz/VBW =3MHz.
- c. Use a video trigger with the trigger level set to enable triggering only on full pulses.
- d. Sweep Time is more than once pulse time.
- Set the center frequency on any frequency would be measure and set the frequency span to e. zero span.
- $\ensuremath{\mathsf{f}}$. Measure the maximum time duration of one single pulse.
- g. Set the EUT for DH5, DH3 and DH1 packet transmitting.
- \check{h} . Measure the maximum time duration of one single pulse.
- i. DH5 Packet permit maximum 1600/ 79 / 6 = 3.37 hops per second in each channel (5 time slots RX, 1 time slot TX). So the number of pulses in the observation period of 31.6 seconds is $3.37 \times 31.6 = 106.6$.
- j. DH3 Packet permit maximum 1600 / 79 / 4 = 5.06 hops per second in each channel (3 time slots RX, 1 time slot TX). So the number of pulses in the observation period of 31.6 seconds is $5.06 \times 31.6 = 160$.
- k. DH1 Packet permit maximum 1600 / 79 / 2 = 10.12 hops per second in each channel (1 time slot RX, 1 time slot TX). So the number of pulses in the observation period of 31.6 seconds is $10.12 \times 31.6 = 320$.

7. HOPPING CHANNEL SEPARATION MEASUREMEN

7.1 LIMIT

Frequency hopping systems shall have hopping channel carrier frequencies separated by a minimum of 25 kHz or the 20 dB bandwidth of the hopping channel, whichever is greater. Alternatively, frequency hopping systems operating in the 2400-2483.5 MHz band may have hopping channel carrier frequencies that are separated by 25 kHz or two-thirds of the 20 dB bandwidth of the hopping channel, whichever is greater, provided the systems operate with an output power no greater than 125 mW.



9.2 TEST PROCEDURE

This is an RF-conducted test to evaluate maximum peak output power. Use a direct connection between the antenna port of the unlicensed wireless device and the spectrum analyzer, through suitable attenuation. The hopping shall be disabled for this test:

a) Use the following spectrum analyzer settings:

1) Span: Approximately five times the 20 dB bandwidth, centered on a hopping channel.

2) RBW > 20 dB bandwidth of the emission being measured.

3) VBW \geq RBW.

4) Sweep: Auto.

5) Detector function: Peak.

6) Trace: Max hold.

b) Allow trace to stabilize.

c) Use the marker-to-peak function to set the marker to the peak of the emission.

d) The indicated level is the peak output power, after any corrections for external attenuators and cables.


e) A plot of the test results and setup description shall be included in the test report.

NOTE—A peak responding power meter may be used, where the power meter and sensor system video bandwidth is greater than the occupied bandwidth of the unlicensed wireless device, rather than a spectrum analyzer.

PKPM1 Peak power meter method:

The maximum peak conducted output power may be measured using a broadband peak RF power meter. The power meter shall have a video bandwidth that is greater than or equal to the DSS bandwidth and shall use a fast-responding diode detector.




