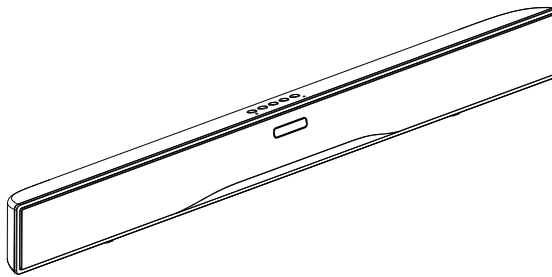

SOME DOS AND DON'TS ON THE SAFE USE OF EQUIPMENT

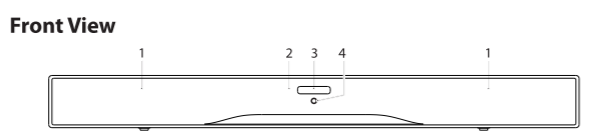
This equipment has been designed and manufactured to meet international safety standards but, like any electrical equipment, care must be taken if you are to obtain the best results and safety is to be assured.

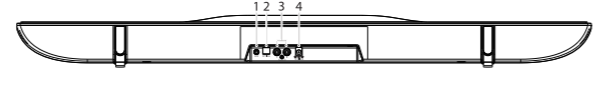

Remove the Plastic Strip from the Remote Control

Remove the plastic strip from the battery if the battery is being used for the first time. It is located at the bottom rear of the remote control.

Battery Replacement for the Remote Control

- The remote control requires a CR2025, 3V Lithium battery.
Slide and hold the battery release tab.
Pull out the battery holder and remove the old battery.

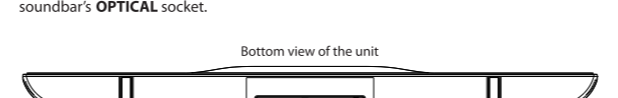

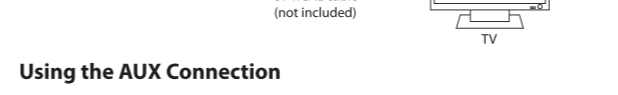
- Remote Control Operation Range:
The remote control sensor on the front unit is sensitive to the remote control's commands up to a maximum of 5 metres away and within a maximum of a 60° arc.
Please note that the operating distance may vary depending on the brightness of the room.

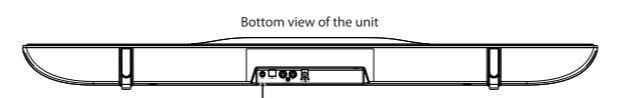
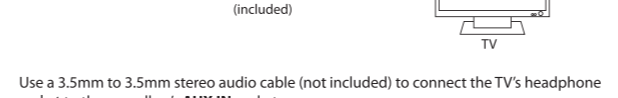
Using the OPTICAL Connection

Maintenance

Cleaning the Unit

Ensure the unit is fully unplugged from the mains socket before cleaning.

- To clean the unit, wipe the case with a slightly moist, lint-free cloth.
Do not use any cleaning fluids containing alcohol, ammonia or abrasives.
Do not spray aerosol at or near the unit.

Attaching Self Adhesive Pads

- Peel back the adhesive cover on the foot pad.
Align and attach the adhesive side of the pad to the foot pad cutaway section on the bottom of the soundbar.
Press the pads firmly to ensure they are well secured.

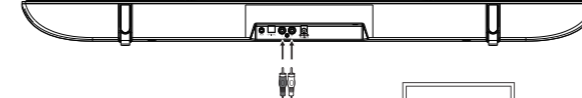

Using the Audio Connection

Use an RCA stereo audio cable (not included) to connect the TV's audio output socket to the soundbar's AUDIO IN (L/R) socket.

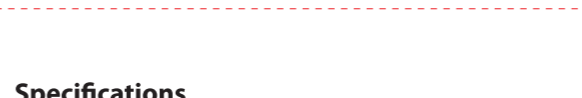
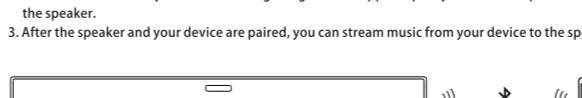
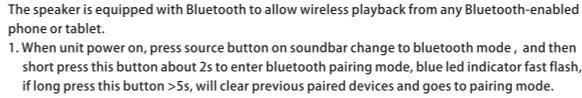
Google Chromecast Built-in

Follow the three steps below to enjoy this feature:
1. Connect phone or tablet to the same Wi-Fi network as your speaker using the Google Home App.
2. Cast podcasts, music, and more from 100+ Chromecast-enabled apps. Tap the Cast button in a Chromecast-enabled app to play music on your speaker.
3. Tap the Cast button in a Chromecast-enabled app to play music on your speaker.

Establish Bluetooth connection

The speaker is equipped with Bluetooth to allow wireless playback from any Bluetooth-enabled phone or tablet.

- When unit power on, press source button on soundbar change to bluetooth mode, and then short press this button about 2s to enter Bluetooth pairing mode.
If long press this button >5s, will clear previous paired devices and go to pairing mode.
Click the device name you entered during Google Home App setup on your device to pair with the speaker.
After the speaker and your device are paired, you can stream music from your device to the speaker.

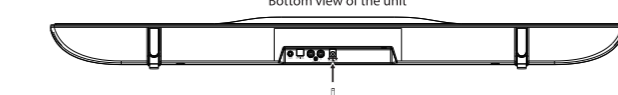
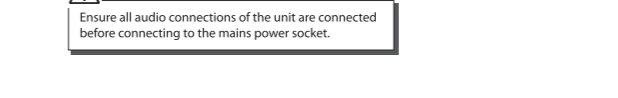
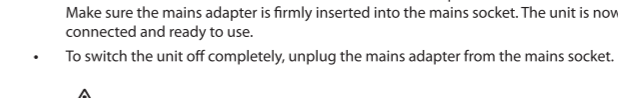

Connecting to the Mains Supply

- This unit is designed to operate with the provided mains adapter.
Connecting the unit to any other power source may damage the unit.
Unwind the mains adapter cable to its full length. Connect the end of the cable to the DC IN socket at the bottom of the unit and then connect the mains adapter to the mains socket.
Make sure the mains adapter is firmly inserted into the mains socket. The unit is now connected and ready to use.
To switch the unit off completely, unplug the mains adapter from the mains socket.

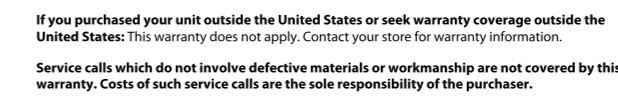
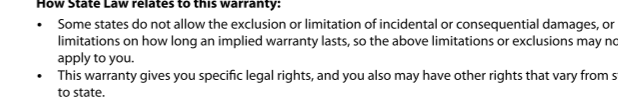
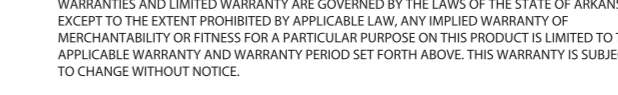


Wall Mounting

Drill 2 parallel holes (Ø 8 mm each according to wall type) in the wall. The distance between the holes should be 445 mm.

Firmly fix 1 dowel (Ø 12x30mm (not included)) into each hole in the wall if necessary.

Insert 1 screw TA 4x40mm (not included) into each dowel. Be sure to leave a 6mm gap between the wall and the screw's head. Lift the unit on the heads of the screws and slot it into place.



General Operation

When you first connect the unit to the mains socket, the unit will be in POWER OFF mode. The LED indicator will not light up. Press @ on the unit or the remote control to switch the unit on ON mode. The LED indicator will light up Red.

- Press @ to switch the unit back to POWER OFF mode. The LED indicator will not light up.
Disconnect the mains plug from the mains socket if you want to switch the unit off completely.

When the unit is idle for approximately 90 minutes, it will automatically switch to Standby mode.

Selecting Modes

Press source on the unit or the remote control to switch between AUX and OPTICAL and BLUETOOTH mode. The LED indicator will light up green if in AUX mode and red if in OPTICAL and blue if in BLUETOOTH mode.

Optical is default mode when unit is switched on at first time.

Adjusting the Volume

- Press VOL +/- on the unit or the remote control to adjust the volume.
If you wish to turn the sound off, press @ on the remote control. Press @ again to resume normal listening.

Google Cast Stream

- Install Google Home app into phone, follow instruction of application for wifi setup and music streaming process.

Source change

- WiFi streaming: Once detected signal from Google cast, auto switch to WiFi mode to play music. In standby mode, still can detect signal and wake up to stream music.
Bluetooth: In Bluetooth mode, once unit is paired with device, can play music, if WiFi is playing music, stop or pause WiFi playing first.
Aux in/Optical In: In AUX/Optical connection, Bluetooth is disabled; if you wake up with 'OK Google', then change to WiFi mode.

Factory Default Resetting

When speaker power on, hold the Mic mute button for 15s, the speaker will reset factory default setting.
