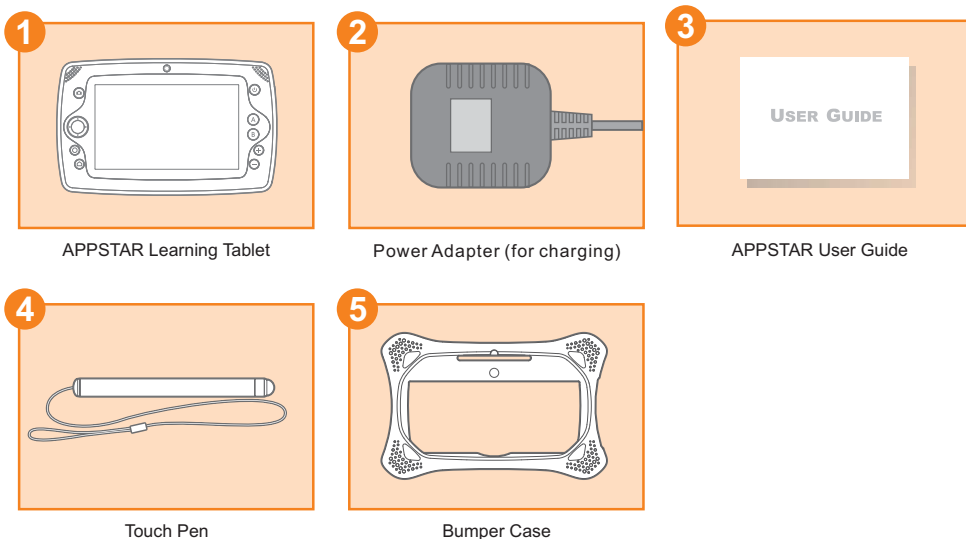
#### APPSTAR main features include:

Please read this manual carefully before using APPSTAR. This allows you to have a better understanding of the features and functions of APPSTAR. We hope this product can bring you happiness.

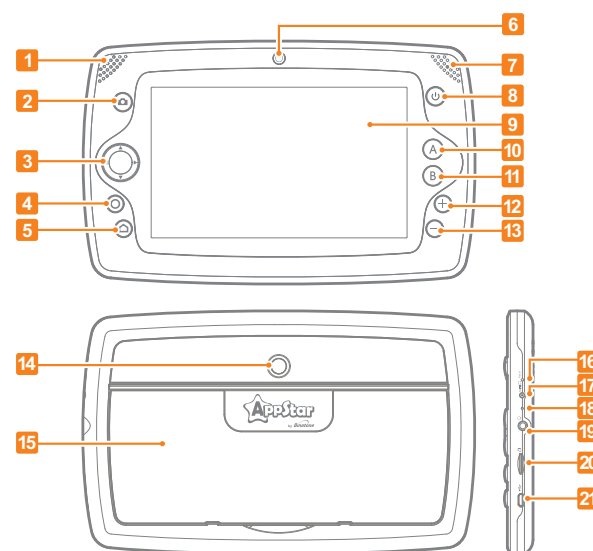

TABZ OS status bar displays APPSTAR information on top of the screen, such as User Name, Time, Alarm Clock, Wi-Fi Status, Battery Status etc.

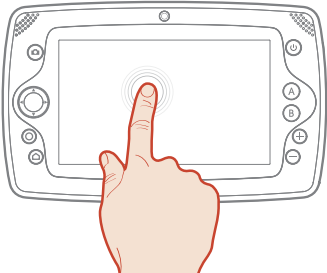
1.4 HOW TO OPERATE

1.4.1 Using the Touch Screen

APPSTAR has a multi-touch capacitive screen. You can operate the touch screen with your finger.

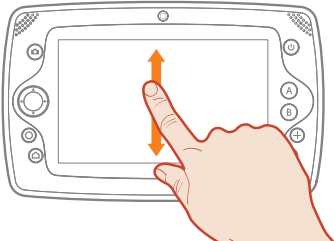
● Tap

With your finger, tap on the icon once to open it.



● Slide

Tap and hold the screen and slide in the direction that you want to scroll.



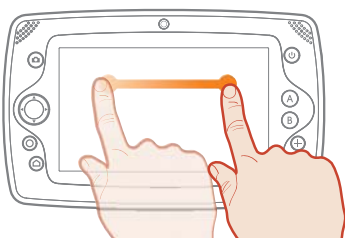
● Swipe

Quickly move your finger on the screen in the direction that you want to scroll.



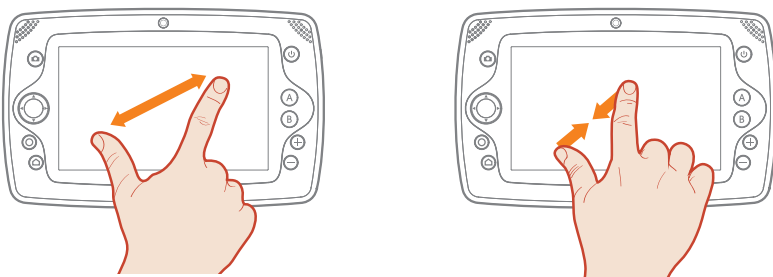
● Drag

Touch and hold on the icon, then drag it to the spot where you want to move.



### ● Zoom

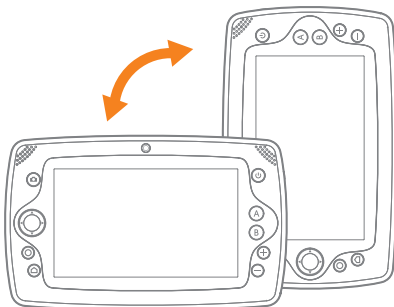
Using two fingers on the screen, pinch together to zoom out or spread apart to zoom in.



### 1.4.2 Using the G-Sensor

#### ● Rotation

Rotate the tablet to change the on-screen display from Portrait to Landscape orientation.



### ● Shake

In some applications, you can gently shake APPSTAR to operate. Make sure APPSTAR is grasped firmly in both hands, the shaking action does not require extreme force.

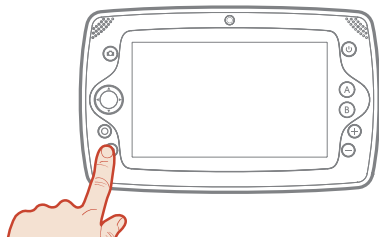


### ● Tilt

In some applications, tilt APPSTAR left or right to control the movement direction.

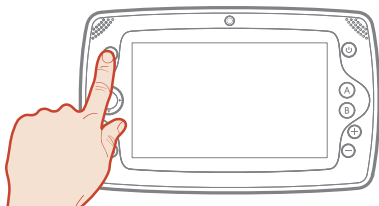

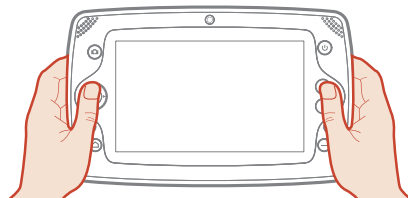


Home key: Return to the previous menu

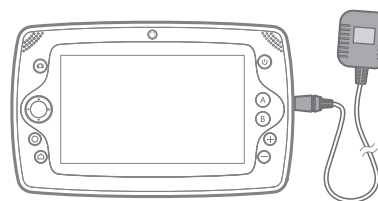

## 1.5 GETTING STARTED

Before using the APPSTAR, please make sure you have read the instruction guidelines thoroughly.

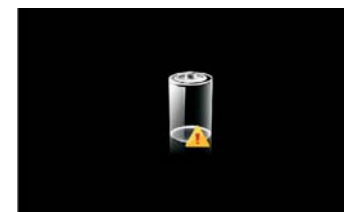
### 1.5.1 Connect the Power Adaptor



Please connect the power adaptor to APPSTAR and a power outlet.

When  icon appears in the upper right corner of the screen, this indicates the tablet is connected to the power adaptor and is charging.

Charge the battery for at least 4 hours before you start using the tablet.



The above diagram indicates the battery level is too low to start the APPSTAR, please charge at least 30 minutes before APPSTAR is able to start again.

#### Caution:

- Only use adaptor with output DC 5V/2A.
- Make sure the input of the adaptor matches the voltage of the country it is being used in.
- For safety purposes, it is recommended to ONLY use the power adaptor that came with your APPSTAR. Using a different power adaptor may damage the APPSTAR.


1.5.2 Power On

Press and hold the power button to turn on. APPSTAR displays a welcome screen before it enters the Main Menu automatically.

1.5.4 Lock/Unlock Screen

Press Power Button to lock APPSTAR.  
**Note:** When auto sleep time is up, the system will automatically lock the screen and go to stand by mode.

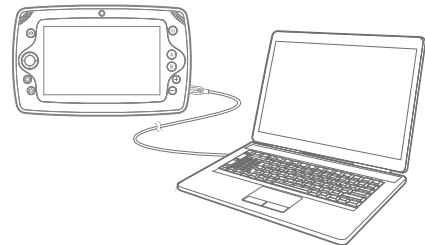


When APPSTAR is locked, briefly press the Power Button to wake up the screen.  
Click and hold the  icon, then slide it towards the right of the screen.

1.5.3 Power Off

Press and hold the power button, the shutdown prompt box will appear, tap “Ok” to turn off, or tap “Cancel” to return to the previous screen.

1.5.5 Connect to Computer



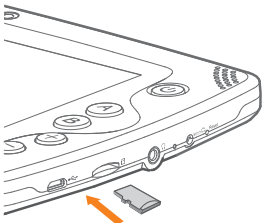
You can connect APPSTAR to your computer in order to transfer your photos, videos, and music to APPSTAR. USB cable (Sold separately) is required.

- 1. Connect the USB cable between APPSTAR and your computer.
- 2. When the connection is completed, a prompt box will appear. If you want to connect, tap “Yes” to open the USB connection page, tap “No” to close the prompt box.
- 3. Tap “Turn on USB Storage” in the USB connection page, and tap “Ok” to confirm.
- 4. After a successful connection, “USB storage in use” will appear. You can start to copy and move files between the computer and APPSTAR. When finished, tap “Turn off USB Storage”.
- 5. Disconnect the USB cable.

1.5.6 Multi-Media File Folder

- 1. When you copy music, pictures and movies/videos files from your computer to the APPSTAR, put them in the correct specified folder on internal memory or Micro SD card. TABZ OS will only read files from a specified folder rather than search from the entire memory space.
- 2. In order to avoid that TABZ OS cannot find the file, please do not remove the specified folders.
- 3. The specified folders are as follows:

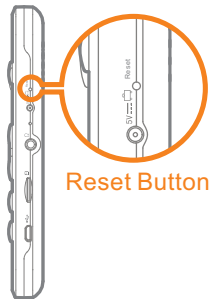
Specified Folder	Content &Support File Type
Music	Music transfer to this folder (Such as .mp3/.wav/.wma) To play the music, go to Main Menu→Music
Pictures	Pictures transfer to this folder (Such as .jpg /.png /.gif /.bmp) To view the photo, go to Main Menu→Camera→Photo Frame
Movies	Movies/Videos transfer to this folder (Such as .wmv/.mp4/.avi/.mov/.flv) To view the video, go to Main Menu→Video Recorder→Video Player



1.5.7 Inserting Micro SD Card

APPSTAR has an internal memory (FLASH memory), and a slot for inserting a Micro SD card of up to 32GB, to provide additional storage space.  
To install the Micro SD card, first switch the APPSTAR to off. Next, open the battery cover and lift the lithium battery out without disconnecting the wires from the unit, put in the micro SD card (sold separately) into the micro SD card slot with its label side up. The card will snap into place, then replace the lithium battery followed by the battery cover.

### 1.5.8 Reset APPSTAR



If APPSTAR malfunctions (ie: screen freezes or keys stop responding), press the reset button using a small pointed object to reset the APPSTAR, then press and hold the Power Button to restart the APPSTAR.


## 2 STARTING WITH APPSTAR

### 2.1 USING APPSTAR FOR THE FIRST TIME

The first time use of the APPSTAR will require you to setup the initial configuration.



#### 2.1.1 Select Language



On this page select the language of your choice. Tap the  icon on the upper right corner to confirm and continue to the next step after selecting the language.

#### 2.1.2 Set Wi-Fi



On this page, you can setup Wi-Fi to connect the APPSTAR to a wireless network. A list of available networks will appear. Tap to select a Wi-Fi network from the list. Enter the password if it is a secured network and tap "Join". When connected successfully,  this icon will appear on the status bar. If you wish to skip set up, turn off the Wi-Fi connection. To manually add other Wi-Fi hotspots, please tap the "Advanced Settings". After setting, tap the  icon on the upper right corner to confirm and continue to the next step.

#### 2.1.3 Set Date and Time



On this page you can set the time on the APPSTAR. You can choose automatic calibration time through the network, or choose to set the time manually. For more advanced settings, please tap the "Advanced Settings".



2.1.4 Set Parent Password

On this page, you will set the parent password. You need this password to login to the parent account and to enter the network module. Also, on this page you will need to enter retrieve password question and answer, which can help you to re-set the parent password when you have forgotten your parent password.

Tips: Parent password in APPSTAR can be used as a master password.

**Note:** Capital letters may not be used in passwords.

2.2 LOGIN

APPSTAR allows up to six individual accounts: four children accounts (New 1 to New 4), one guest account and one parent account.

- **Children Accounts**  
These accounts are for children use. In these accounts, children can use all the pre-installed applications and can save game data. Children also can use the specified network function and applications downloaded from the Internet if a parent consents. Please see Section 3.1 Website Filtering and Section 3.2 Application Manager.
- **Guest Account**  
This account is for guest. In this account, guest can only use the pre-installed applications.
- **Parent Account**  
This account is only for parents. In this account, parents can manage all children accounts, set system configurations, download applications and enter Android OS. Please see Section 3 Parent Control.

2.2.1 Create Account

**1.** 1.Select a child account (New 1 - New 4).

**2.** Enter a user name

**3.** 1.If you want to create a password, click the "User Password" box then create a password.  
**Note:** Capital letters may not be used in passwords.





**4.** Select a built-in cartoon picture or take a new photo as a head portrait.

**5.** Enter a greeting.  
This greeting will be displayed on the first screen after you login.

**6.** Select wallpaper as your desktop background.

2.2.2 Delete Account



In the login page, the  icon will appear in the upper-right corner of the screen after you create a user. If you want to delete a user account, tap the  icon, then the  icon will appear, tap on the  icon on the user account to be deleted and the following interface will appear :



Then enter the user password or parent password, and then tap "Confirm" to delete the user account.  
**Note:** Deleting a user will clear all the data of the user.

2.2.3 Login Account



Tap the user account in the login page to log on. If a password is required, enter the user password on the pop-up password input panel.



Log on to the parent account, a parent password is required and must be entered.

2.2.4 Forgot Password





**For children accounts:** If children forget the user password, a parent can enter the parent password to log on and modify the password in User Settings. Please see Section 2.4.10 Tools → User Settings → Edit user.



**For parent account:** If a parent forgets the parent password, the parent can tap "Forgot Password" in the password input panel to enter the Forgot Password page. Input the Hint Question's answer that set it in the Set Parents Password. If the answer is correct, you can re-set the parents password.

2.3 GREETING



Displays the user's name, head portrait and greeting. It will automatically jump to the Main Menu of TABZ OS after three seconds, or manually slide the screen from right to left into the Main Menu.  
To select another user, press  to go back to Login Interface or press on the  button of the APPSTAR:

## 2.4 MAIN MENU



Includes Learning, Games, e-Books, Camera, Video Recorder, Music, CONNY App, Kids' App, My Favorites, Tools, CONNY Store and Wi-Fi, total of 12 functions.

### CHILDREN ACCOUNT



**Tips 1:** On the Main Menu of the children accounts, slide from right to left to return to the Network Module, slide from left to right to enter the Greeting.

### PARENT ACCOUNT



**Tips 2:** On the Main Menu of the parent account, slide from right to left to the Network Module; on the Main Menu of the parent account, slide from left to right to enter then slide left again to parent control, slide right again to Greeting.

## 2.4.1 Learning



Includes 100 children learning applications divided in 2 groups TOUCH and D-PAD. The applications in the TOUCH group operate with the Touch screen and those of the D-PAD operate with the D-PAD and buttons. Operating mainly by touch.

## 2.4.2 Games



Includes 70 games divided in 2 groups TOUCH and D-PAD. The applications in the TOUCH group operate with the Touch screen and those of the D-PAD operate with the D-PAD and buttons.

## 2.4.3 e-Books



Includes 10 interactive fairy tale books enabling the child to learn reading and to listen to stories being read.

## 2.4.4 Camera



Includes three parts: Effects Camera, Photo Frame and Camera games. Camera games contain 8 games: Anger Management, Image DIY, Photo Puzzle, Distortion Mirror, Stamper, Photo Style, Reality Battle and Love Test.

## 2.4.5 Video Recorder



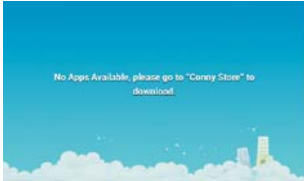
Includes three parts: Effects Recorder, Video Player and Video games. Video games contain 8 games: Video Sticker, Video morph, Magic Video, Bridge, Pot Pit, Doodle, Style and Catch Insects.

2.4.6 Music



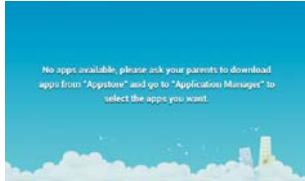
"Music" can play audio files in APPSTAR internal memory and Micro SD card external storage.

2.4.7 CONNY App



The CONNY App includes applications downloaded and installed from "CONNY Store" that were designed and created for children. Children can use safely without parent concern of content.

2.4.8 Kids' App



Kids' App includes applications downloaded and installed from "Appstore." The applications from "Appstore" can be used only after parents consent. Please see Section 3.2 Application Manager.

2.4.9 My Favorites



**Note:** Only after playing the creative gaming applications on Learning, Camera & Video sections, the Specified Folder "My favorites" can be found on Micro SD card or Internal memory when APPSTAR is connected to computer. You can copy these photos, videos & works from APPSTAR to computer.

My Favorites is a collection of photos and videos taken by the user and the works created by the user when playing the creative gaming applications. The specified folders are as follows:	
Specified Folder	Content
My favorites/<user>/photos	Photos save in this folder after playing some of the creative gaming applications on Section 2.4.4 Camera
My favorites/<user>/videos	Videos save in this folder after playing some of the creative gaming applications on Section 2.4.5 Video Recorder


2.4.10 Tools



The Tools include Friends, Alarm Clock, Calendar, Stopwatch, Calculator, Voice Memos, File Manager and User Settings.

● Friends



This is a useful address book management application. You can manage friends' information (name, contact information, address, etc.). Tap the  icon on the upper right corner of the screen can add a new friend.




Add Friend: Add a new friend's information.




Edit Friends: Select a friend in the friends list to view the friend's information.




Tap the  icon on the upper right corner of the screen; you can modify the information of the friends.



If you want to delete the friend, tap the  icon on the lower left corner of the screen.



"Delete" will appear above the  icon. Tap the "Delete" to confirm removing the friend.

### ● Alarm Clock

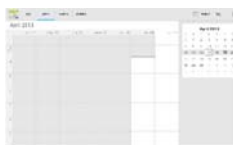


**Alarm settings:** Select the time in the time box. Select a ringtone in the Alarm Ring list. Select the number of weeks.



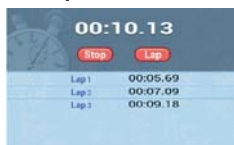
**Ring:** When the alarm rings, a full-screen animation pops up, tap the icon to stop the alarm clock.

### ● Calendar



Where you the user can browse the calendar and manage your schedule. (Calendar account registration is required)

### ● Stopwatch



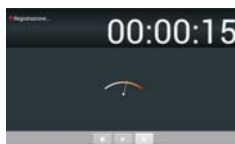
This is a simple stopwatch, accurate to the millisecond display. Tap "Start" to start the timer, tap "Stop" to stop the timer. Tap "Lap" to record the timing of multiple time points. Tap "Reset" to reset the time.

### ● Calculator



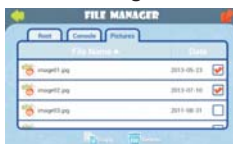
This is a calculator application, not only can it do a simple four operations, it can also do complex scientific calculations.

### ● Voice Memos



This is a voice memo application, where users can record a voice message. You can play the recorded files on APPSTAR. To do this, go to the Music → Playlists → My recordings to select the record.

### ● File Manager



This is a file manager application. The user can view the files of APPSTAR internal memory and micro SD card external storage, copy and delete the files. Tap icon, then tap to select the corresponding file.  
1) To copy file: tap icon, then copy the file from APPSTAR to micro SD card or from micro SD card to APPSTAR.  
2) Tap icon, then tap "Yes" to confirm you wish to delete the file.  
**Note:** you can only copy and delete a file; you cannot copy and delete a folder in the File Manager.

### ● User Settings



The user can modify personal information (username, head portrait and password) as well as greeting and desktop wallpaper.

## 2.4.11 CONNY Store



The CONNY store is designed for APPSTAR users to shop for children applications online. It includes a large number of parent-approved applications. To purchase, download and use these applications, you will need to register an account by following the instructions appearing on the screen.

## 2.4.12 Wi-Fi



On this page, parents can setup Wi-Fi connection. Choose the name of Wi-Fi in the list of Wi-Fi hotspots; tap "Join" to connect to the network. If it is a secured network, enter the password and tap "Join". To manually add other Wi-Fi hotspots, please tap the "Advanced Settings".



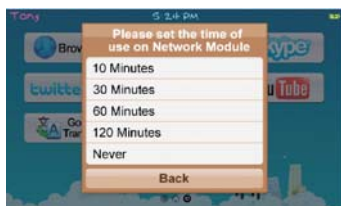
## 2.5 NETWORK MODULE



The network module contains various fast entrances such as Internet Browser (By default, the Website filtering is activated, see Section 3.1 Website Filtering), E-mail, etc... which can be managed by parents. Use of the fast entrances will need parent authorization, see Section 3.2 Applications Manager.



A parent password is needed when entering the network module.



You can set the time line of how long children can stay in this module.

## 3 PARENT CONTROL



Parent control includes Website Filtering, Application Manager, System Settings, Appstore and Android.

### 3.1 WEBSITE FILTERING






Website filtering can help the parent to control what websites children can visit, children can only view and visit the website in the white list. Parents can set separate white lists for each individual child account.



Tap "Add New" and enter the URL in the pop up box to add a new URL to the white list.

Tap "Default" to restore the factory default white list.




- Tap the  icon on the lower left corner, then tap  icon and the URL will be deleted from the white list.
- After modifications are completed, tap the upper right corner  icon to confirm the changes.
- Website filtering can be activated or deactivated.

## 3.2 APPLICATION MANAGER

Parents can set individual application configuration for each child account.




In the Kids' App, parents can select applications into the individual children accounts for children to use safely.

- Tap the  icon to decide if the application appears in the children accounts. Tap "Unlock All" or "Lock All" to quickly set up all states of the application;
- Tap the  icon on the lower left corner, then tap the  icon, the application will then be deleted;



In the Network Module, parents can choose which fast entrances network functions children can use safely.

- Tap the  icon to decide if the fast entrance appears in children accounts.
- Tap "Unlock All" or "Lock All" to quickly set up all states of the application.

**Note :** When modification is done tap the  icon on the upper right corner to confirm changes.

## 3.3 SYSTEM SETTINGS







System Settings includes Tablet Settings, Change Parent Password and Factory Data Reset.

### 3.3.1 Tablet Settings



Contains Volume, Brightness, Rotation Lock, Auto Sleep, Voice Prompt and Touch Sounds.

- **Volume:** slide left and right to change the system sound volume.
- **Brightness:** slide left and right to change the brightness of the display screen.
- **Rotation Lock:** Tap the  icon to enable or disable the Auto-rotate screen function.
- **Auto Sleep:** Select a sleep time in the pop up box, no operation within the time, APPSTAR will enter sleep standby mode.
- **Voice Prompt:** Tap the  icon to turn on or off the menu tone.
- **Touch Sounds:** Tap the  icon to turn on or off the touch screen sound.
- **Default settings:** Tap "Default Settings" to reset the system settings to the default state.

**Note:** After editing, tap the upper right corner  icon to confirm the changes.

### 3.3.2 Change Parent Password



Parents can change the parent password and change the retrieve password question and answer.

**Note:** To change the password you will need to enter the original password.

### 3.3.3 Factory Data Reset



Tap "Factory Data Reset" to restore the factory settings. Parent password is required.

**Caution:**

This action will erase all the data in APPSTAR. Before performing this operation please back up data to a computer or SD card.

### 3.4 APPSTORE


This is an app market where the parents can download additional applications. After the download and installations are complete, the parent can now allow the children to play with these apps. Go to the "Application Manager" to set. Please see Section 3.2 Application Manager.


**Remark:**

- 1) WiFi connection is needed.
- 2) For first time use, you must wait during the downloading and installation of APPSTORE.

### 3.5 ANDROID



Tap "Android", parents can go into Android OS. If you want to return to TABZ OS, you can tap the  icon on the status bar at the bottom right of the desktop.

Then tap the  icon again in the popping up box, you will return to the TABZ OS.


## 4 IMPORTANT INFORMATIONS

### 4.1 SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not arbitrarily throw, demolition, impact, microwave, fire, paint APPSTAR
- Avoid placing APPSTAR in the rain or other wet environments or liquid.
- Be careful not to place it near food
- If APPSTAR accidentally gets wet, immediately unplug the external power supply, open the battery cover and remove the battery. Confirm that the APPSTAR did not get any water inside and it is completely dry before re-booting.
- To prevent the APPSTAR screen from being damaged, touch the screen lightly.
- Do not use sharp objects to operate the screen.
- Do not throw, squeeze, impact, bend, or bite the battery. This could cause a short circuit.
- When playing, please maintain a comfortable level of lighting in the room, too bright or too dark can be harmful to your vision.
- It is recommended that parents monitor their children for appropriate play and length of play time.
- Avoid playing games when under stress or for prolonged periods causing tiredness. Please rest when feeling tired, a 15 minute break per hour is advised when playing games for prolonged periods of time. Anyone with heart problems or high blood pressure should take concern when playing games. If you don't feel well, please discontinue use and see a doctor promptly.
- If your eyes become tired or sore while playing, please discontinue use and see a doctor if the condition continues.
- If you feel dizzy, nauseated or tired please discontinue use of playing the game. Please consult a doctor if the condition continues.
- If you have any existing wounds on your hand/wrists or other parts of your body, please take care not to cause your condition to worsen by playing games. You should seek your doctor's advice first before playing.
- Don't use the headphones for prolong periods of extended time, this may cause hearing loss or ringing in the ears. If you notice a change in your hearing, please see a doctor promptly.

## 4.3 TROUBLESHOOTING

- IMachine will not boot up**  
 Plug in the power adapter, charge for at least 30 minutes and attempt to boot again.  
 If you still cannot boot, try to reset the APPSTAR (see section 1.5.9), if not resolved please contact local seller.
- Headphones cannot hear the sound**  
 Please check the APPSTAR if the volume is set to 0, verify the headphones are connected properly or check if the headphones or headphone cords are damaged.
- Appear crash (Freeze)**  
 Press the reset button using a small pointed object to reset APPSTAR, then press and hold the power button to restart APPSTAR.
- Not be able to connect to the computer**  
 If APPSTAR is in standby mode, briefly press the power button to wake up the system.  
 If APPSTAR is in the normal state, enter the Android OS, go to "Settings" -> "Developers" check "USB debugging" option, if checked, uncheck it.
- Not be able to connect to Wi-Fi networks**  
 Please check any Wi-Fi network nearby and verify the Wi-Fi network works exists and is functioning properly. If it is a secured network, enter the password.
