**BRIEF INTRODUCTION**

**a. Bluetooth Wireless communication technology**

Bluetooth is a standard of close range radio communication technology that was drawn up by Ericsson, IBM, Intel, Nokia and Toshiba. Through Bluetooth technology, we can achieve the highest transmission rate among mobile phone, computer, printer, PDA and other devices. The max transmits range of class II devices are 10 meters.

• Next Track and Previous Track

• Play/Pause

• Answer call, End call, Redial last call

• Volume Adjustment

• Can also be used as Wired Headphone (Without MIC)

**Note:**

• Some of these functions need to be supported in your Mobile phone.

**Headset must be in on mode, even to use it for wired mode.**

**BEFORE USING**

a. Overview:

1. Microphone/Call button (MIC)  
2. Play/Pause/Answer  
3. Previous Track / Volume Down  
4. Next Track / Volume Up  
5. Power On/Off Switch / LED Indicator  
6. Charging port  
7. Charging pin  
8. Broken LED

**b. Charging Battery of the Bluetooth Headset:**

**First time charging:** This Headset has a built-in rechargeable battery; it is recommended to charge the battery fully before using it for the first time.

**LOW Power:** The Headset will switch OFF automatically when the battery is fully drained (at this time you have to charge the battery of the Headset).

**Charging the Headset with Travel Charger**

**STEP 1:** Connect the travel charger using USB cable to the charging port of the headset

**STEP 2:** Plug the travel charger in the stranded AC Power outlet.

**Charging the Headset with USB Cable**

**STEP 1:** Connect charging cable with charging port of the headset

**STEP 2:** Insert USB charging cable into USB port of PC / Laptop.

**Note:**

• When the Red Light is ON the headset is charging

• When the Red Light turns OFF the headset is fully charged.

• It takes approximately 3Hrs to fully charge the headset.

**Warning:**

1. The battery is recycled.

2. Do not dispose of the battery in fire, as it may cause Explosion.

**BASIC OPERATION**

**a. Switching ON/OFF the Headset**

Function	Operation	LED Indicator
Switch On the Headset	Switch the Power button Upwards (Blue Light blinks with Power ON voice prompt)	The Blue light blinks every two seconds
Switch Off the Headset	Switch the Power button Downwards (Red Light blinks with Power OFF voice prompt)	The Red light blinks and Headset gets switched OFF
Enter into pairing mode	After Switching Off the headset, it automatically gets in to be pairing mode with only Blue LED blinking. But if you want to put the headset in pairing mode Manually then you have to press and hold the Play/Pause Button till you hear voice prompt as "Pairing" and also the "RED" and "BLUE" LEDs start blinking alternately	Blue LED glows every second in auto mode and Red and blue LEDs glows alternately in Manual mode

**Remark:** Please switch Off the headset manually whenever not in Use for battery saving

**b. Pairing the Headset with Bluetooth Mobile Phone**

You have to pair the Bluetooth headset with Mobile phone before using it for the first time. Please make sure your mobile phone has Bluetooth function. Specific pairing procedures may vary with different mobile phones. Please refer to your mobile phone user manual for further information.

**The steps are as follows:**

**a. Pairing with Bluetooth Mobile Phone :**

1. Keep the headset and Bluetooth mobile phone within 1 meter range.

2. Make sure that your headset is OFF.

3. Switch ON the headset until you see the Blue LED Glowing every 2 seconds. It automatically get in pairing mode or In Switch ON mode press Play/Pause button until you hear voice prompt as "Pairing" and Red and Blue LEDs glows alternately.

4. Switch ON the Bluetooth function of your mobile phone and search for Bluetooth device.

After searched, select "Ball Rust BTH" in the Bluetooth device list.

5. According to indication, enter password or PIN No: "0000", and press the key of " Yes" or "confirm"

6. After successful pairing, select "Ball Rust BTH" in the Bluetooth device list, and press, "connect", After successful connecting, the indicator light will flash every 5 seconds.

**Remark:**

• The pairing mode will last for 5 minutes. The indicator light will flash Blue than the headset will switch to standby mode automatically. If it can't pair with any devices after 5 minutes, If you want to continue to pair the headset with Bluetooth device, please switch off the headset first, and then re-pair according to the steps "1 ~ 6" above.

• After pairing is successful, the headset and mobile phone will remember each other, no need to re-pair when use next time.

• When you switch on the headset every time, it will automatically connect to the last paired device. If you want to pair with other Bluetooth devices, please switch Off the Bluetooth function of the current Bluetooth device. And then pair and connect it with new Bluetooth device according to steps "1 ~ 6" mentioned above.

**Wearing the headset**

The Headbands are adjustable; please adjust it accordingly to enjoy music more comfortably.

**Making Call with the Headset**

**a. Basic Operation**

Functions	Status of headset	Operation
Redial/End a call	Standby mode	Long Press "A" Button
Answer/End a call	Conversation mode	Short Press "A" Button
Volume Down	Conversation Mode	Long Press "W" button
Volume Up	Conversation Mode	Long Press "W" button

**Remark:**

• Not all the mobile phones support all the functions listed above. Please refer to the instructions of your mobile phone user manual for further information.

• When the volume is adjusted to Max. Or Min. you will hear an indication sound

**b. Playing Music**

Functions	Status of headset	Operation
Volume Up	Conversation Mode	Long Press "A" button
Volume Down	Conversation mode	Long Press "W" button
Pause	Playing Music	Short Press "W" button
Play	Pause	Short Press "W" button
Next Track	Playing Music	Short Press "A" once
Previous Track	Playing Music	Short Press "A" once

**Remark:**

• For some of mobile phone, when they are playing music, the sound will transfer to the speaker of the mobile phone, you have to choose "transfer the sound through Bluetooth" in the "setting" of Music player, and select "Ball Rust BTH" in the device list. The music will be transmitted to the headset, please refer to the instruction of your mobile phone user manual for further information.

• Control the function of last song / next song / Pause / Play, it needs your mobile phone to support AURCP, Please refer to the instruction of your mobile phone user manual for further information.

• If your mobile Music player has an option to ON/Off the stereo mode, then switch it ON mode and select "Ball Rust BTH" in the device list for better sound quality. Please refer to the instruction of your mobile phone user manual for further information.

• If you insert 3.5 mm Audio cable, the Headset will not turn OFF and will start playing from the device where you have connected the other end of the stereo cable. Once you disconnect the Audio cable from Rust BTH you can start using it in Bluetooth mode again. But in Line-in Mode there will be no headset controls Play/pause, Next Track, etc. available, we can use it for listening Music through Mobile Phones or PCLaptops without MIC.

**Note :**

• All the above multimedia functions may not be supported.

• wired(stereo) mode will be w/o mic.

• While using the headset in BT mode if stereo cable is inserted in headset, BT mode will not get disconnected in background.
