When photos arrive, they'll play on a slideshow. Swipe to scroll through photos.



If you love a photo, **tap the Heart button** in the lower right of the screen, and **we'll email the sender to tell them you loved it!**



Skylight requires wi-fi to receive new photos, but you can still **view photos** without a wi-fi connection.



To **zoom into a photo** so it fills the screen, take two fingers (e.g. your two index fingers) and **pinch to zoom**.

Tap the screen to see the **Settings Bar**. From here you can:

- **Delete** photos
- Rotate photos
- Pause on a favorite photo
- View a **Gallery** of all your photos
- Tap Advanced Features to change the slideshow speed or shuffle your photos
- Tap How It Works to check your Skylight email address or reset your WiFi

1. SET UP

- Screw the plastic support stand into the hole on the lower right on the back of Skylight.
- If you prefer to mount Skylight on the wall, you can use the hole on the upper back of Skylight.



2. TURN ON

- Connect the adapter to Skylight it plugs into the small hole on the back that says DC IN.
- Connect the adapter to an outlet.
- In about 30 seconds, the home screen will appear.



3. CONNECT

- A list of available WiFi networks will appear on the right side of the screen. Tap to choose your network from the **list.** Swipe up and down if the list is long.
- If the name of your network does not appear, wait for 30 seconds and check again.
- If your WiFi requires a password, a prompt will appear. Type in your **network's password** using the on-screen keyboard. Don't make any typos!
- Skylight will let you know once it has successfully connected.



4. ACTIVATE

- Visit www.ourskylight.com/register and follow the instructions there to pick your unique Skylight email address.
- Once you create your Skylight email, our online system gives you a 6-digit code.
- Just tap that code into your Skylight device after turning it on the first time, using Skylight's on-screen keypad.
- Skylight will automatically retrieve your unique Skylight email address and display it on the screen.



5. SHARE

- Now everyone in your family can email photos (as attachments) to your Skylight email address (e.g. janesmith@ourskylight.com).
- The subject and contents of the email don't matter - Skylight just grabs photo attachments.
- About 60 seconds after photos get sent, they appear on your Skylight!
