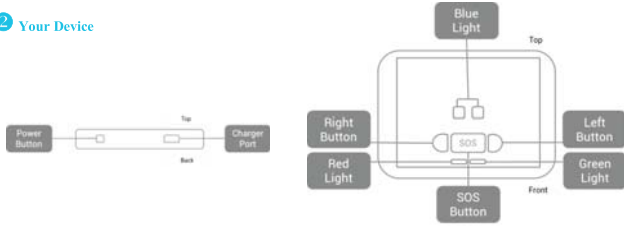

## 3 Install and Charge the Battery

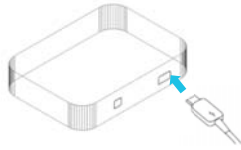
Your battery will not be installed or charged when you first unpack your device.

Install the battery by unscrewing the back cover and insert the battery.

To charge, connect one end of the data cable to the charger port at the bottom of the phone, and the other end to a power USB adaptor.

Then connect the USB adaptor to a power outlet. Charge the device for 12 hours.

The USB port is used for charging or upload software.



## 4 Turn on your device for the first time

Ensure that your tracker has a working SIM installed.

Place your device outside.

Press the red button for 3 seconds.

The green led on the front of the device should flash for 3 seconds.

Activate your device by browsing to [trackimo.com](http://trackimo.com)

The activation process requires the Device ID and Device Key, which are found on the back of your Trackimo Device.

## A simple App interface

Trackimo's web and smartphone-based App provides a single point of contact for activation, settings, and simultaneous tracking of multiple devices. Users may view multiple trackers on a single map. Other App features include custom notifications based on motion, battery status, impact or acceleration, and the crossing of user-defined "geo-fences", which can be drawn directly on the map. Device settings, including tracking frequency and power status, are accessible remotely via the Trackimo App.

## Return the location of the tracker

To know location of your Tracker, send an SMS to Tracker and it will report its location by SMS.

## Tracking on Map

Download trackimo APP from [trackimo.com](http://trackimo.com). Start the APP,

Input the latitude and longitude that you receive from the tracker by SMS and click the search button.

## SOS Function

When you meet an emergency, you can press the SOS button and used MIC for help. The loudspeaker(Buzzer) is used for alarm when battery power is lower.

## Limited Warranty

The Trackimo Device, the Trackimo Battery Cradle, and any other hardware accessories, excluding external batteries and SIM cards, which are provided to YOU concurrently and in conjunction with the Trackimo Device specifically for use with YOUR particular model of Trackimo Device (which together comprise the Trackimo Hardware), will be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period that is the shorter of (i) one (1) year from the date that the new Trackimo Device was first purchased by YOU as an original end-user ("YOU") and (ii) the period ending upon YOUR breach of the Trackimo End-User/Software License Agreement (the "License Agreement") entered into between YOU and Trackimo LLC and/OR its affiliated group of companies' in connection with the Trackimo Solution (the "Warranty Period").
