


### Battery Safety Information

Controller: Requires 2 x "AAA" (R03) batteries (included).  
Train: Requires 3 x "AAA" (R03) batteries (included).



**Battery Instructions**  
1. Remove batteries when not in use or discharged.  
2. Do not mix old and new batteries.  
3. Do not use rechargeable batteries.  
4. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.

Replacement of batteries must be done by an adult. Dispose of batteries safely. Never dispose of batteries in fire, as they may leak and explode.

Product is shipped in "OFF" mode. Please switch from "OFF" to "ON" for normal play mode.







### To Play


**1** Switch from "OFF" to "ON" to start Play mode.




**2** Switch from "OFF" to "ON" to start Play mode on the Train.




**3** Ready Light Power Button



**4** 3-Position Remote Controller.




**5** Hook the cars together and place them on the track. Make sure the engine is in front and align all wheels on the track.




• Hold the remote controller with the stick facing you. Point the remote controller toward the train and push the stick forward **1**. The train moves forward around the track.  
• Pull the stick back a little to stop the vehicle **2**.  
• Pull the stick all the way back and the vehicle travels in reverse **3**. Release the stick to stop **2**.


You can also play without the remote controller.  
• Press the button on top of the second train.  
• Pressing once will move the train forward.  
• Pressing again will stop the train.  
• Pressing twice in succession will move the train backwards.




Rotate station to choose a different direction.




Reel piano down into train cart.



Billboard pops up as train passes. Make sure to push back down.



Push the mail into the train cart.



**Hint:** We do not recommend using the engine on carpets. For best performance, use on the track provided or hard, flat surfaces.

**Hints:**  
• If you do not operate the remote controller for two minutes, the vehicle shuts off. Press the vehicle power button and operate the remote controller to restart.  
• This toy works best if you have a clear path between the remote controller and the vehicle.  
• Point the remote controller at the vehicle. The maximum range of the remote controller is about 12 feet (3.66 m).  
• Wipe the toy with a clean, damp cloth. Do not immerse.
