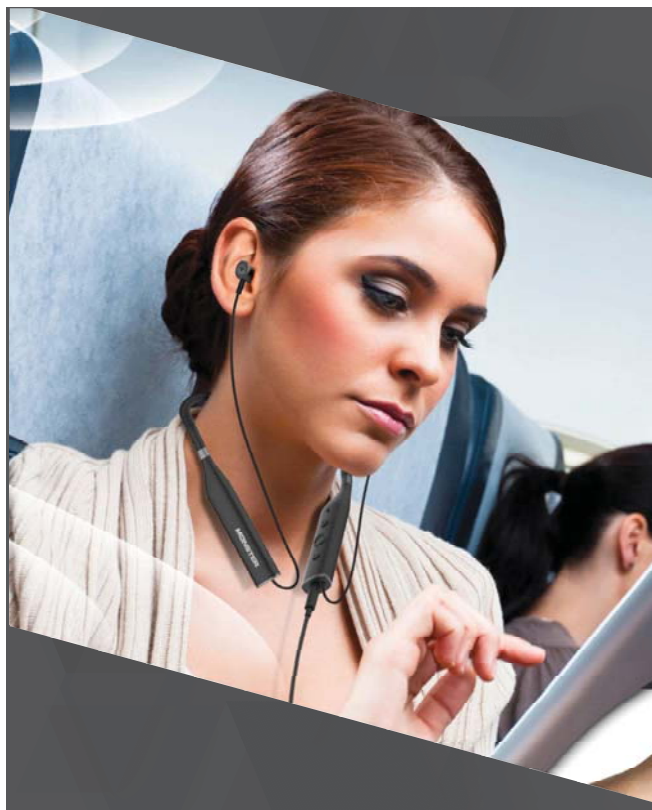

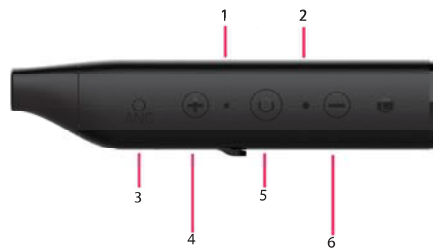

### KEY BEHAVIOR

- 1. Turn ON Power: press and hold  for 2 seconds
- 2. Turn OFF Power: press and hold  for 3 seconds
- 3. Vol+: Short Press 
- 4. Vol-: Short Press 
- 5. Previous:  Press and hold 2 seconds
- 6. Next:  Press and hold 2 seconds
- 7. Play/Pause:  Short press
- 8. Accept calls:  Short press
- 9. End a call:  Short press
- 10. Reject an incoming call:  Press and hold for 2 seconds
- 11. Launch Voice Assistant: Double-Click 

**KEY BEHAVIOR** *continued*

- 12. Turn Off ANC in Power off mode: Short press ANC button
- 13. Turn On ANC in Power off mode: Press and hold ANC button for 2 seconds
- 14. Turn Off ANC in Power on mode: Short press ANC button
- 15. Turn On ANC in Power on mode: Short press ANC button
- 16. Reconnect when disconnected: Double click Multifunction button
- 17. Voice transfer in calling:  Press and hold for 2 seconds
- 18. Mute in calling:  Press and hold for 2 seconds
- 19. Enter pairing mode: Press and hold  and  together for 3 seconds
- 20. Three-Party Conference: During the call, double click the  button to receive the seconds incoming call, the first coming call will enter the call hold, double click the  button to switch between two calls freely; During the call, click the  button to answer call and hang up the current call.

Bluetooth is always in pairing state after being turned on the first time

#### **CHARGING**

New headphones will have enough power for pairing and dialing out but need to be fully charged to use for a prolong time. The RED LED will flash quickly when in low battery, Red LED will blink while charging, Red LED will turn solid after fully charged; 1-2 hours are needed for a fully charged battery.

#### **RESET MODE FOR HARDWARE RESET**

Connect the headphones to the computer via Micro USB cable. When red LED light flashes, headphones reset is finished.

#### **AUTO POWER OFF TO SAVE BATTERY IN BATTERY MODE**

1. If the FLEX is on and Bluetooth has disconnected over 15 minutes; the FLEX will auto power off to save battery.
2. The FLEX will power off to charge when power cable is connected.

Remarks: The FLEX can auto power off if Bluetooth is connected and battery is too low

**VOLUME CONTROL**

1. Volume range: 0-16
2. Volume will remain the same after the FLEX is powered Off/On.
3. Short press "VOLUME -" key once to decrease volume, the "chime" tone will sound off once after pressing "Volume -" key again when volume reaches minimum level.
4. Short press "VOLUME +" key once to increase volume, the "chime" tone will sound off after press "Volume +" key again when volume arrive maximum position

**AUDIO TONE**

"Connected" tone will sound off when main unit has paired successfully.




**BLUETOOTH PAIRING DISTANCE**

BT distance > 10m

**BATTERY REQUIREMENT**

1. It takes 1-2 hours to fully charge the FLEX.
2. Battery playback time is over 8 hours with ANC Off mode.
3. Battery playback time is over 7 hours with ANC On mode.


#### **OTHER**

1. Incoming call status:  
If a call comes in when the phone is playing music through Bluetooth, the music will be stopped and the phone will be playing the ring tone;  
When the call is ended, the FLEX will resume the music playing
2. The operation of Conference call by three parties:  
Short press the multifunction button, pick up the new incoming call and end the current call; When headphones are in use and a new call is in coming, double press the  button to pick up the new call, and previous call will stay connected and vice versa.  
To Pairing, When headphones are connecting, press and hold the key  and  together for 3 seconds to enter pairing mode and the 'Pairing' audio tone sound off.

#### **Connection loss due to transmission distance out of range**

The Flex will say "Pairing" when it is out of range and when there is a link loss with the Bluetooth device that it is connected to. The Flex will attempt to connect for 5 minutes during link loss.

#### **To reconnect**

When headphones are disconnecting and are within transmission range, Double press  button 2 times to reconnect last smart phone.

#### **CHARGE**

Les nouveaux écouteurs auront assez d'énergie pour le couplage et la numérotation, mais ils doivent être complètement chargés pour pouvoir être utilisés pendant une période prolongée. Le voyant DEL ROUGE clignote rapidement lorsque la batterie est faible. Il clignote pendant la charge et demeure allumé en continu après la charge complète. Entre 1 et 2 heures sont nécessaires pour une charge complète de batterie.

#### **MODE DE RÉINITIALISATION POUR LA RÉINITIALISATION MATÉRIELLE**

Connecter le casque d'écoute à l'ordinateur via le câble Micro USB. Lorsque le voyant DEL rouge clignote, la réinitialisation du casque est terminée.

#### **MISE HORS TENSION AUTOMATIQUE POUR ÉCONOMISER LA BATTERIE EN MODE BATTERIE**

1. Si le FLEX est allumé et que Bluetooth s'est déconnecté dans les 15 minutes, l'unité FLEX s'éteint automatiquement pour économiser la batterie.
2. Le FLEX s'éteint pour se recharger lorsque le câble d'alimentation est branché.

Remarques : Le FLEX peut s'éteindre automatiquement si Bluetooth est connecté et que la batterie est trop faible.
