


## Important Safety Precautions

## A Quick Look at Your Device

## 1. Charging Port

You can plug one end of the included USB Charging Cable into this jack, while plugging the other end into a USB port on your computer in order to charge your speaker's built in lithium battery.

#### 2. AUX IN

You can connect additional audio sources into your speaker using the included 3.5mm auxiliary cable.

## A Quick Look at Your Device (continued)

#### 1. Volume Down

Decreases the volume of your speakers

## 2. Play/Pause

Press to play or pause a track

#### 3. Volume Down


Increases the volume of your speakers


## 4. LED Status Light

This light helps you determine the status of your speaker as it charges or pairs with a Bluetooth audio source

#### 5. ON/OFF Switch

Slide this switch to the ON position to power on your speaker. Slide this switch to the OFF position to power off your speaker







## Charging Your Speaker

1. Connect one end of the included USB Charging Cable to the Charging Port on your speaker. Then plug the other end of the USB Charging Cable into a suitable USB port on your computer to recharge your speaker's internal rechargeable battery.

NOTE: The internal battery of your speaker takes approximately four hours to charge when completely drained.

2. When charging, a red LED light will illuminate to indicate that the unit is charging. The red light will turn off when your unit is fully charged.

## Understanding the LED Status Lights

## When Charging Your Speaker

Solid Red LED = Charging Red LED OFF = Charge Complete

## When Pairing Your Speaker to a Bluetooth Audio Source

Blinking Red and Blue LED: Bluetooth not connected. (Ready to pair.)

## Pairing Bluetooth Devices to Your Speaker

In order to pair your Bluetooth audio device to your Bluetooth Speaker for the first time, follow the steps below:

- 1). Make sure your Bluetooth audio source is held within three meters of your speaker.
- 2). Slide the ON/OFF switch on your speaker to the ON position. The LED light will alternately blink red and blue to indicate that you have entered pairing status.
- 3). Go to the Bluetooth Manager of your Bluetooth audio source. Please refer to the User's Manual of your Bluetooth audio source for more information.
- 4). Search Bluetooth devices and select "TA-11BTSP" to start connecting.
- 5). Enter "0000" if your device asks for the PIN code.
- Once paired, the blue LED light will turn on steadily and you can use your speaker to listen to audio from your Bluetooth sound source.

### AUX IN Mode

When the included 3.5mm Auxiliary Cable is connected to the AUX IN jack, the system will automatically pause any audio being streamed from a paired Bluetooth device. The blue LED light will turn off and the speaker will enter into AUX IN mode. Audio will be played from the sound source connected to the 3.5mm Auxiliary cable.
