


Motorized Train Car

- Use a Phillips head screwdriver to remove the bottom battery cover
- Remove demo batteries and install new batteries
- Insert 2 "AAA" 1.5V batteries in the polarity shown
- Replace the battery cover and tighten




Remote Controller

- Use a Phillips head screwdriver to remove the bottom battery cover
- Insert 2 "AA"1.5V batteries in the polarity shown
- Replace the battery cover and tighten






• Turn on the Train



• Push the left/right button, let the train turn left/right



• Push the Mute button to turn off the sounds



Demo sound button
Push the top of the bell for demo sounds
(only available when the train is turned off)

Tips

The train and remote controller will go to sleep model if there is no operation for 10 minutes (the train light will flicker and no sound). Need to push the left/right button on the remote controller to trigger again.
