Summary

This test report supports an application for certification of a transmitter operating pursuant to: CFR Title 47 FCC Part 15.247, ISED Canada RSS-247 Issue 2

The SCD1001 operates in the 902-928MHz frequency range and has a wire antenna with 4.55dBi peak gain. It is powered by AC input up to 347V.

We found that the product met the above requirements without modification. Test sample was received in good condition.



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Test Methodology

All testing was performed according to the following rules/procedures/documents; CFR Title 47 FCC Part 15.247, RSS-247 Issue 2, RSS-Gen Issue 4, FCC KDB 558074 D01 DTS Measurement Guidance v04 and ANSI C63.10-2013.

Radiated emissions were maximized by rotating the device around 3 orthogonal planes (X, Y and Z) as well as varying the test antenna's height and polarity. The worst case results were recorded.

RF measurements were performed at the antenna port on 3 channels as follows:

902.7MHz: Low Channel915MHz: Mid Channel927.3MHz: High Channel

AC line conducted emissions testing was performed with a $50\Omega/50\mu H$ LISN.






Low Channel Peak Output Power

High Channel Peak Output Power












30-1000MHz Radiated Emissions Test Setup


99% Occupied Bandwidth Low Channel


