PAIRING THE SPEAKERS

- Ensure the speaker is turned off. If they are not, please turn off the speaker first before pairing.

- 3. Place the speaker and the Bluetooth® device to which you would like to pair it within the operating distance. We recommend keeping the two devices no further than 33 feet apart.
- 4. Once you have activated Bluetooth® on your device. select "HY-TIMBRE" from the list of available Bluetooth®
- 5. Ensure Bluetooth® is enabled on your phone or music device. Refer to the manufacturer's instructions for how to enable Bluetooth® on your device.
