### 5.2. Limits

For frequency hopping systems operating in the 2400-2483.5 MHz band employing at least 75 non-overlapping hopping channels, and all frequency hopping systems in the 5725-5850 MHz band: 1 watt. For all other frequency hopping systems in the 2400-2483.5 MHz band: 0.125 watts, the e.i.r.p shall not exceed 4W.

## 6. Carrier Frequency Separation

### 6.1. Block diagram of test setup



### 6.2. Limits

Frequency hopping systems shall have hopping channel carrier frequencies separated by a minimum of 25 kHz or the 20 dB bandwidth of the hopping channel, whichever is greater. Alternatively, frequency hopping systems operating in the 2400-2483.5 MHz band may have hopping channel carrier frequencies that are separated by 25 kHz or two-thirds of the 20 dB bandwidth of the hopping channel, whichever is greater, provided the systems operate with an output power no greater than 125 mW.

### 6.3. Test procedure

- (1) The test according to ANSI C63.10-2013 clause 7.8.2.
- (2) Connect EUT's antenna output to spectrum analyzer by RF cable, the path loss was compensated to the results.
- (3) Set the EUT as maximum power setting and enable the EUT transmit continuously.

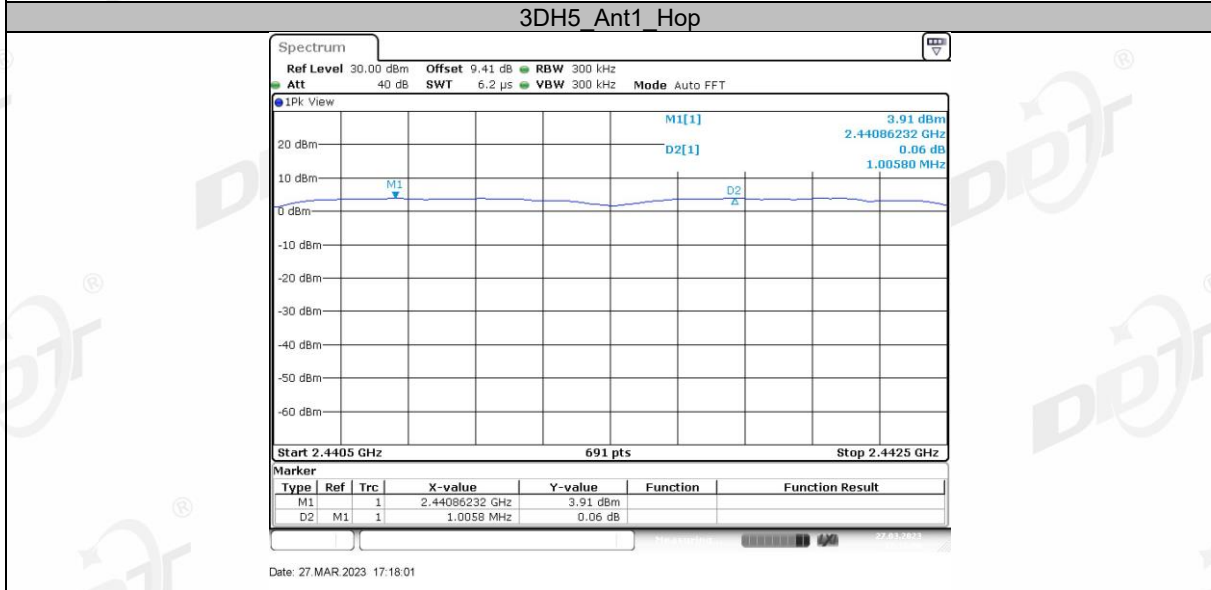
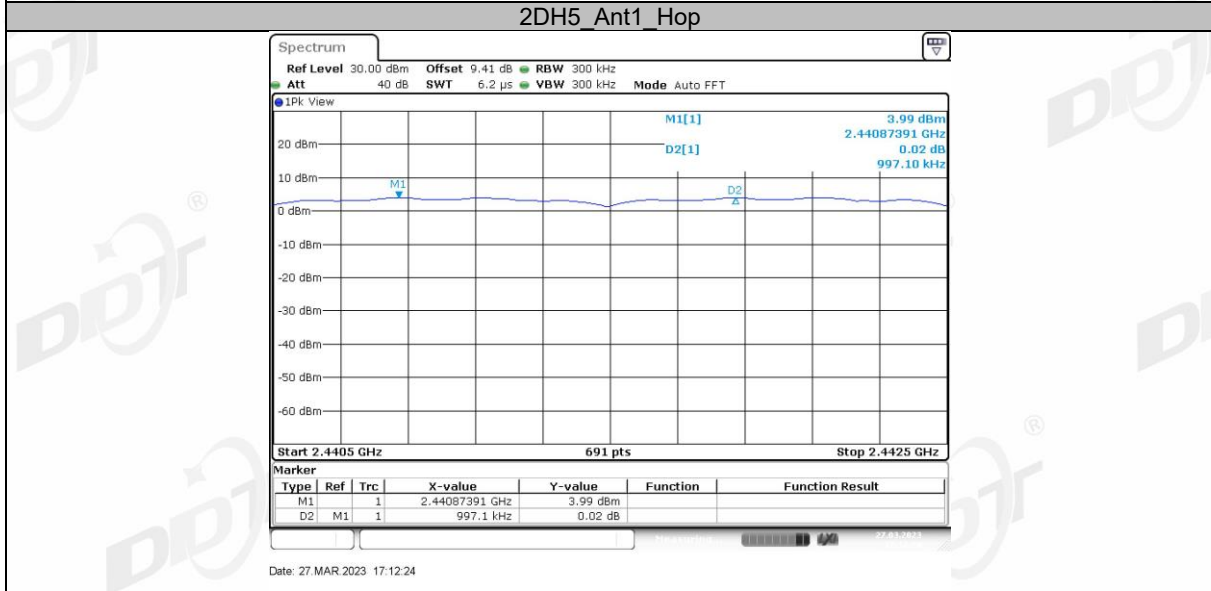
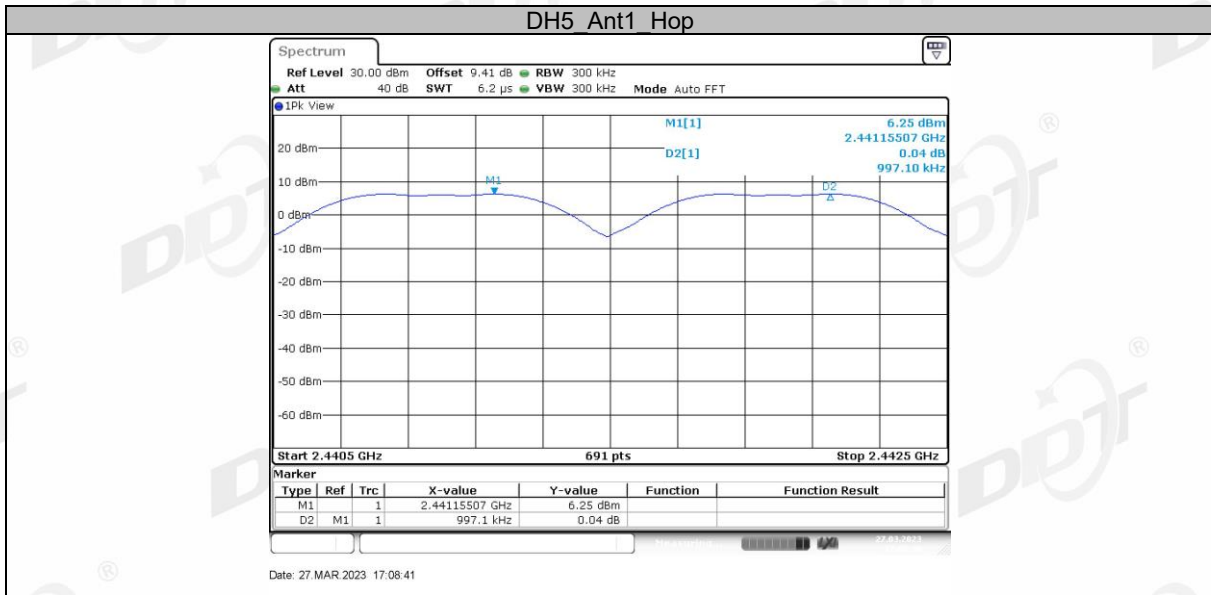

The average time of occupancy on any channel shall not be greater than 0.4 seconds within a period of 0.4 seconds multiplied by the number of hopping channels employed.

### 7.3. Test procedure

- (1) The test according to ANSI C63.10-2013 clause 7.8.4.
- (2) Connect EUT's antenna output to spectrum analyzer by RF cable, the path loss was compensated to the results.
- (3) Set the EUT as maximum power setting and enable the EUT transmit continuously.
- (4) Use the following spectrum analyzer settings for the maximum peak output power measurement:

Frequency hopping systems in the 2400-2483.5 MHz band shall use at least 15 channels.

### 8.3. Test procedure

- (1) The test according to ANSI C63.10-2013 clause 7.8.3.
- (2) Connect EUT's antenna output to spectrum analyzer by RF cable, the path loss was compensated to the results.
- (3) Set the EUT as maximum power setting and enable the EUT transmit continuously.
- (4) Use the following spectrum analyzer settings for the maximum peak output power measurement:

RBW:	RBW to less than 30% of the channel spacing or the 20 dB bandwidth, whichever is smaller.
VBW:	VBW $\geq$ RBW.
Span:	The frequency band of operation
Detector Mode:	Peak
Sweep time:	Auto
Trace mode:	Max hold

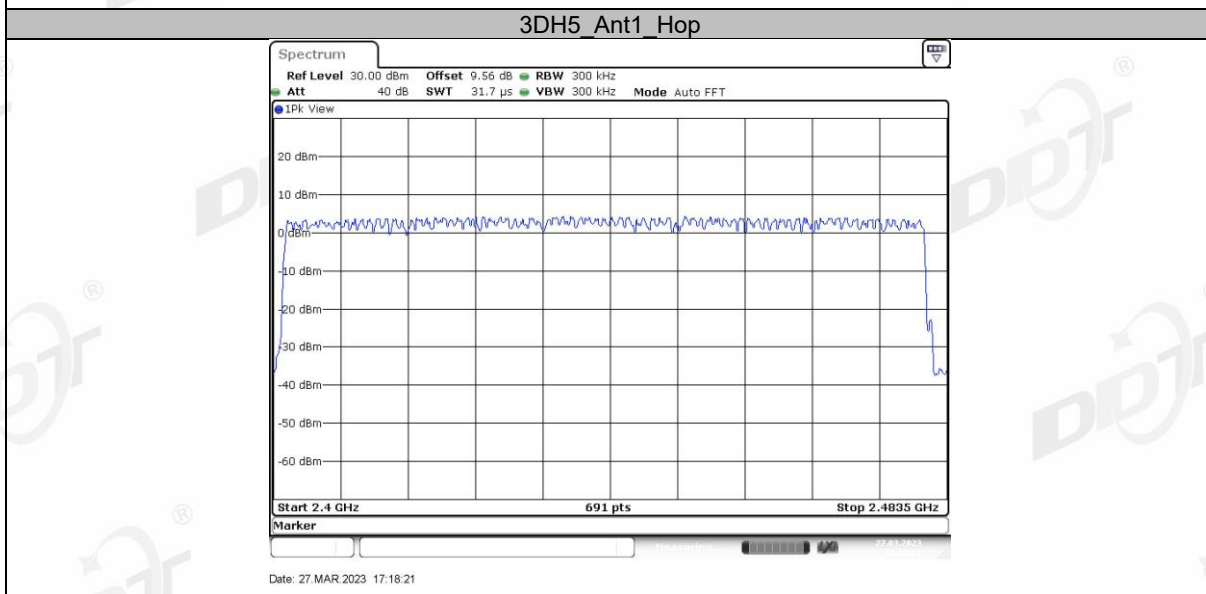
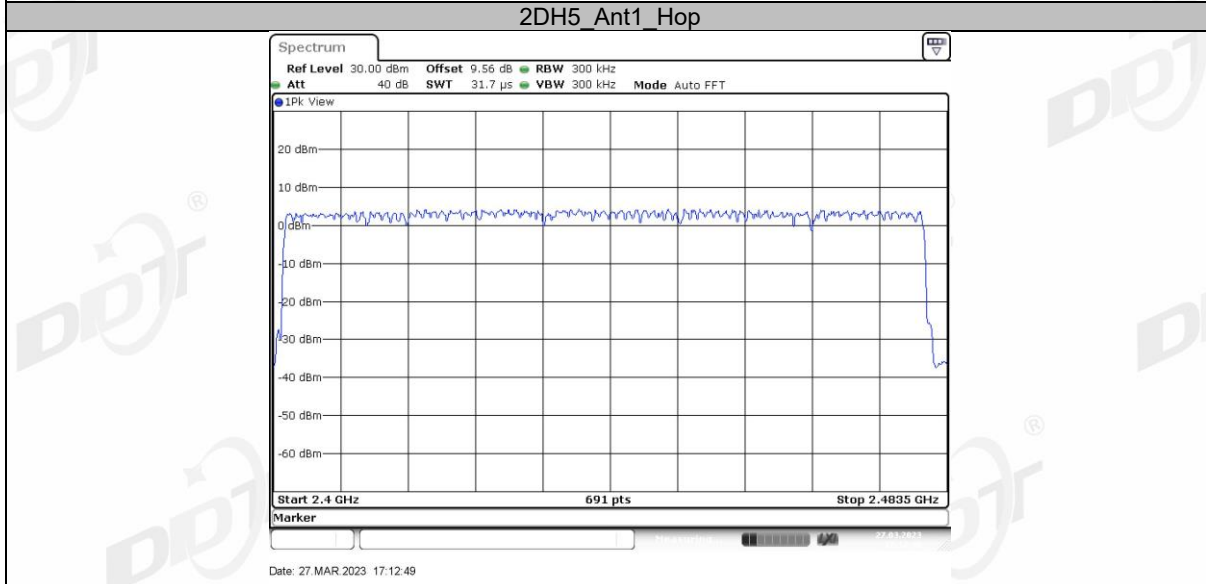
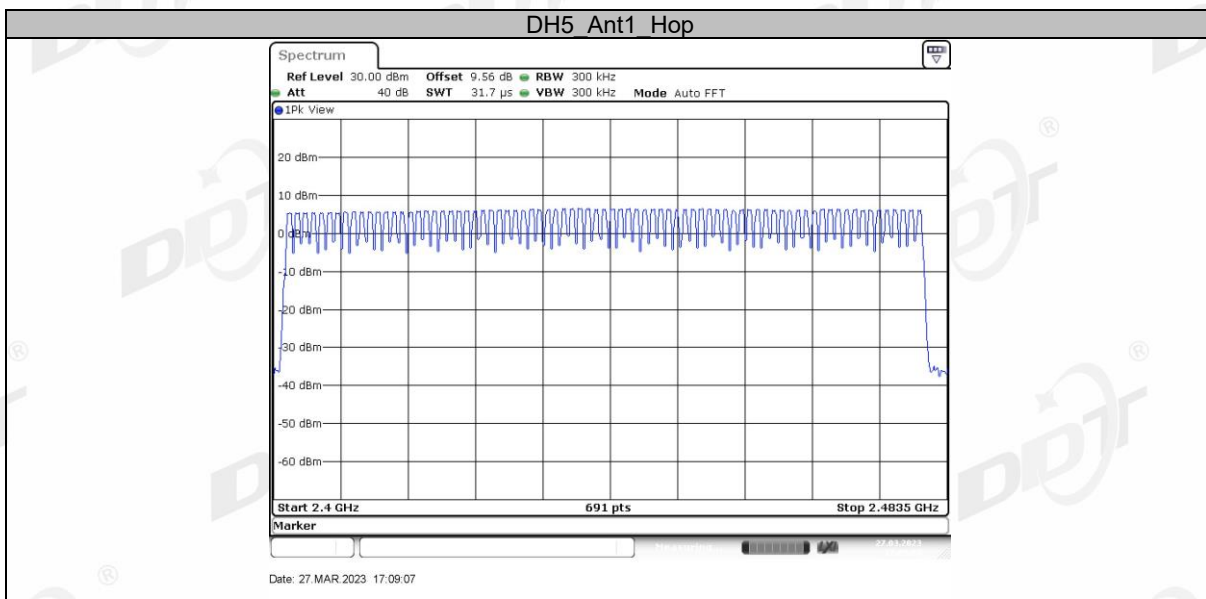

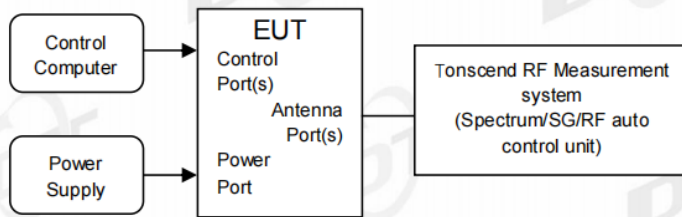


**3DH5 Ant1 High\_2480**



## 10. RF Conducted Spurious Emissions

### 10.1. Block diagram of test setup



### 10.2. Limits

In any 100 kHz bandwidth outside the frequency bands in which the spread spectrum intentional radiator is operating, the radio frequency power that is produced by the intentional radiator shall be at least 20 dB below that in the 100 kHz bandwidth within the band that contains the highest level of the desired power.

### 10.3. Test procedure

- (1) Connect EUT's antenna output to spectrum analyzer by RF cable.
- (2) Establish a reference level by using the following procedure:

Center frequency	Test frequency
RBW:	100 kHz

Span	Wide enough to capture the peak level of the in-band emission

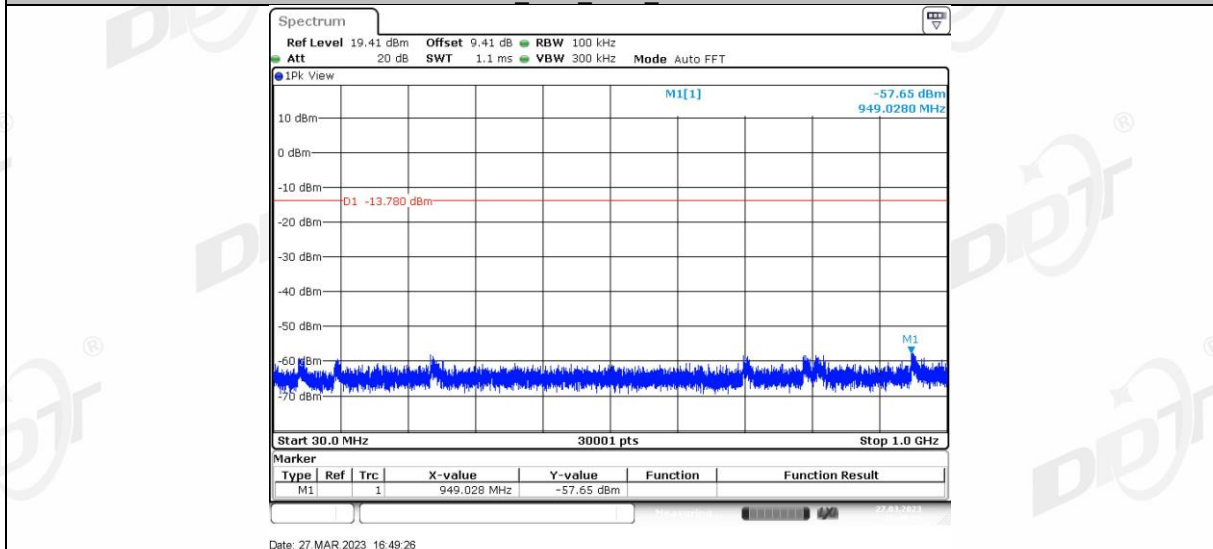
