CHARGING THE SPEAKER

- 1. Insert the charging cable into micro USB input port, connect the USB plug into $5\mathrm{V}$ USB power terminal. The LED indicator will turn ON
- 2. After charging is completed, the LED indicator will turn off.

Note: When music sound become lower and you hear a warning tone "beep", please charge this speaker as soon as possible

WIRELESS PAIRING FOR AUDIO PLAYBACK



- 1. Turn on the speaker by pressing "@" button for 3 seconds. The speaker will have a voice prompt and a blue indicator will flash.
- 2. Turn on your device and activate the Bluetooth function. Search for Bluetooth pairing name "AZ Mini Speaker" and click to pair, The speaker will pair automatically and the speaker will have a voice prompt, the blue indicator light will flash slowly.
- 3. Turn off the speaker by pressing "@" button for 3 seconds, and the speaker will emit a "beep" sound

- 1. When you can't play the music, please refresh the Bluetooth connection.
- 2. When receiving a phone call just press the "@" button to answer it.
- 3. To pause and play music just press the button.
- 4. To redial your most recent phone call, please double press the button.
