

Charging

- 1. Insert the included charging cable's USB-C end into the port on the case.
- 2. Insert the charging cable's standard USB end into the USB port of a computer or suitable wall adapter (not included).
- 3. The LED Indicator will flash green when the case is charging and turn solid green when it is fully charged.

Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Take out the earbuds from the case and they will turn on automatically.
- *If the earbuds are out of the charging case, put them into the case and take out again to turn on.
- 2. When in pairing mode, both earbud's indicator light will flash green.
- 3. On your phone, go to the Bluetooth page in the settings app. Make sure Bluetooth is on before connecting to the available device '011 gaming tws'.
- 4. Both earbud's LED Indicator will turn solid green once paired to your phone.

Using Your Earbuds

1. Press either earbud's Multi-function button to play and pause music.

- 2. Press the left earbud's Multi-function buttonthree times to go back to the previous song.
- 3. Press the right earbud's Multi-function button three times to go to the next song.
- 4. Press either earbud's Multi-function button twice to activate Siri or Google Assistant.
- 5. Press either earbud's Multi-function button to answer and end a call.
- 6. Press and hold either earbud's Multi-function button for 3 seconds to reject an incoming call.
- * TWS Earbuds can be used independently. One earbud can be used when the other is off, as long as connected to Bluetooth.
- * To turn off the earbuds, press and hold the Multi-function button 5 seconds or put them back to the charging case.
