## WIRELESS LOCATOR TAG

### INSTRUCTION MANUAL

IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ BEFORE USING THIS PRODUCT

Thank you for purchasing the AZtech wireless tag with the latest low energy wireless technology, version 4.0. This tag can be attached to your valuables or easily lost items through the downloadable app that will track the bluetooth tag. In unimpeded environments, this tag has a 75 foot range to keep track of your kids, pets, and belongings.

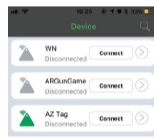


#### SWITCHING ON/OFF

Turn ON: Press and hold the button on the AZ Tag for 3 seconds, until you hear 2 beeps.  
Turn OFF: Press and hold the button on the AZ Tag for 3 seconds, until a long beep will sound.

#### WIRELESS PAIRING WITH TAG

1. Download the AZ Tag app with the above QR code and open app.  
2. AZ tag will automatically try and connect with your smart phone when powered ON. If the app shows the tag to be "Disconnected", connect again by pressing the "Connect" button on screen.



\* The app can track more than one AZ Tag, click the Q button to find more AZ tags to connect with.  
Hit the @ button to add a photo, rename the device, set a ringtone, etc...  
\* To delete slide the tag name to the left on the device list.

#### LOCATION

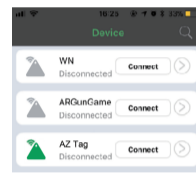
1. If you placed a AZ Tag in your car and need to find it in a large parking lot, push the button on the tag before leaving your car. That will mark the location of your car in the app. When trying to find your car, go to the "location list" in the app and select your car to bring it up on the map with a pin-drop marking spot.  
2. If the item you placed the AZ Tag on is lost, go to the "lost history" and select the item you wish to find.  
Note: To delete items on the list slide to the left and select delete.



#### SETTING THE ALERT

As shown in the image.

1. Double click on the desired AZ Tag to trigger the alert on the smartphone.  
2. Click the red flashing button to stop the alert on the phone.  
3. Click the "Alert" button to trigger the alert on the AZ Tag, click the "stop alert" to end the alert from the tag.



#### PHOTOS

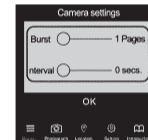
1. Press the "Photography" button at the bottom of the app screen.  
2. Press the top right and left to set the flash and which camera app will use.

To change the settings on the camera mode, press the right button to set for burst shooting and time interval between shots.

\* the AZ Tag can also be used as a remote for your camera phone through the app, just press the button on the tag once.

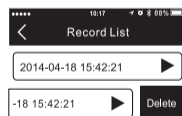
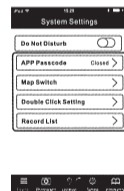

#### SETTINGS

In the app settings menu:

1. Do not Disturb - shut down all connected tags to the app.  
2. APP password setting - protect the location of your goods with a personal password  
3. Map switch: select the map service to use with this app (Google maps or Badu maps)  
4. Record list - list of recorded audio stored in this app.

Press ► button to play and || to pause with a "delete" button on the right.



#### BATTERY REPLACEMENT

Each AZ Tag uses a Cr2032 cell battery. To gain access to the battery, use the side of a coin to twist the back battery cover to the right to open the battery cover. After replacing the battery, place the cover back on the tag and twist to the left.
