


Charging Your Speaker



Pairing Your Speaker with a Bluetooth Device



 Press and hold the power button for approximately 3-4 seconds to power ON or power OFF your speaker.
 The multicolor LED light will be automatically turned on once the speaker is powered on.



2. The indicator light between the M button and charging port will slowly flash blue.



3. Go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone. Make sure that Bluetooth is turned on. Connect to the device listed as "V60099BT".



4. The indicator light between the M button and charging port will steadily shine blue to indicate that your speaker is paired with your phone.

Using Your Speaker



Press the power button to play or pause a track.



Press the + button to skip to the next track in a playlist. Press and hold the + button to increase volume.



Press the - button to go back to the last track in a playlist. Press and hold the - button to decrease volume.



Press the light button to switch different light modes. Press and hold the light button to turn off the LED light. Press the light button again to turn on the LED light.



Press the power button to answer and end a call.
Press and hold the power button to reject an incoming call.
Double press the power button to activate
voice assistant on your connected smartphone.

Modes

Your speaker has various music modes. Press the Mode button to switch between USB,TF, AUX, and Bluetooth Mode.



USB/TF Mode

After inserting a USB drive into the USB port, your speaker will automatically activate USB mode and play any mp3 audio files it finds on your USB drive. After inserting a memory card into the TF card slot, your speaker will automatically activate TF mode and play any .mp3 audio files it finds on your memory card. If your speaker does not change modes, remove your USB drive or TF card and re-insert it.

AUX Mode

Insert an auxiliary cable (not included) into the AUX-IN Jack to listen music from another device, your speaker will automatically turn on AUX mode.

Note: Some of your speaker functions and controls may be unresponsive on AUX mode.

Maintenance and Care

- -Before using your speaker, inspect the ports to make sure that they are clear of dust and debris before charging.
- -Use a soft cloth to clean your speaker. Never use any harsh chemicals or detergents, Make sure your speaker is dry before charging.
- -When your speaker is not in use, it should be stored in a cool, dry place.
- -Never tug or yank on either USB charging cables while they are connected to your speaker. Connect and disconnect these cables as carefully as possible.
- -Never expose your speaker to high temperatures, extreme cold, high humidity or excessive moisture or water.
