


Please fully charge the headset's battery before using it for the first time.</li><li>2. Approximately 1.5 hours are required to fully charge the headset.</li><li>3. The indicator light turns red while being charged, and will turn off after being fully charged.</li><li>4. Low battery<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- If the battery is not charged, the headset will turn off.</li></ul></li></ol> <h3>Pairing</h3> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Ensure the headset is on and your device is within 3 feet to activate the Bluetooth function on the phone. Press on the MF Button for 3 seconds to enter pairing mode.</li><li>2. Select "AMPLIFY SBN80" from the found devices list in the phone's Bluetooth menu. Your device will now be paired with the headset.</li></ol>	<h3>Answering Ending Calls</h3> <p>When a call is coming in, Briefly press the MF button to answer the incoming call. Briefly press the MF button again to end the incoming call. Briefly press the MF button twice to activate the last number redial. The headset will beep and then call the last number dialed.</p> <h3>Audio Streaming</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Play: Briefly press the MF button.</li><li>- Pause: While playing music briefly press the MF button.</li><li>- Next Song: Long press on the Volume Down Button.</li><li>- Previous Song: Long press on th the Volume Up Button.</li></ul>
<h3>Out Of Range</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- If the paired devices are separated by a range of 33 Feet or more, the headset and handset will disconnect.</li><li>- If the headset and handset do not automatically reconnect when they are back within the required range, please reconnect manually.</li></ul> <h3>Maintenance</h3> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Do not use abrasive cleaning solvents to clean the headset.</li><li>2. Do not allow the headset to touch any sharp objects as this will cause scratching and damage.</li><li>3.
