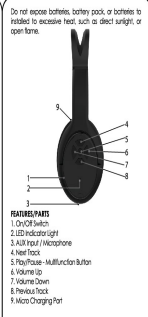

CHARGING THE HEADPHONE

The headphones come with a built-in rechargeable battery. After using it for the first time, we recommend you charge the battery fully. Only use the supplied USB cable to charge the headphones.

Connect the USB cable to a computer USB port and the USB plug in the charging jack of the headset. The red LED light will illuminate while the headphones are charging.

At a charge of the battery takes around 4 hours. When the battery is fully charged, the LED light will turn off.

Manually. Disconnect the headset of this part. The headset will be ready for use.

When the battery is low, the LED will flash red for 30 seconds and then a warning beep. When the headphones charge up, the headset will be ready for use.

TURNING HEADPHONE ON/OFF

Power On/Off: Press ON/OFF switch to ON position and the LED flashes blue.

Power Off: Press ON/OFF switch to OFF position and headset will shut off.

PAIRING THE HEADPHONE

- Ensure the headphones are turned off. If they are not, please turn off the headphones first before pairing.
- Press ON/OFF switch to ON position and the LED flashes blue.
- Place the headphones and the Bluetooth device to which you want to pair it while the operating distance. We recommend keeping the two devices no further than 10m apart.
- Press Bluetooth icon on your phone or music device to enter the manufacturer's instructions for how to pair the Bluetooth with your device.
- Once you have authorized Bluetooth on your device, select the headphone "DG-4345" from the list of available Bluetooth devices.
- Place the pairing code on the headphones will ask for two minutes. If the device are paired after two minutes, the headphones will automatically return to standby mode.
- If pairing is successful, turn off the headphones first and repeat following the observations steps. Once you have paired the headphones with a device, the headphones will remember the device and will pair automatically when the device's Bluetooth is switched on in standby mode. You do not need to repeat any previously connected devices.

CONNECTING TO MUSIC

Once the headphones are paired to your device, you can stream music wirelessly to the earphones. Select the

track you wish to listen to on your device to listen via earphones. Should you encounter any problems while streaming, please refer to your device user manual.
