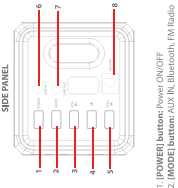

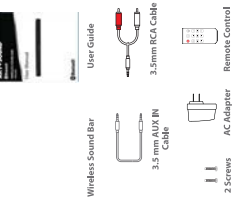
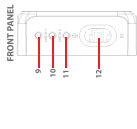

User Manual

Location of controls



1. POWER button: Power ON/OFF
2. MODE button: AUX IN, Bluetooth, FM Radio
3. VOL+ key: Increase volume
4. VOL- key: Decrease volume
5. [M] button: Mute
6. LINE IN 1: AUX IN Jack
7. LINE IN 2: AUX IN Jack
8. IR [F] key: Infrared sensor



Installing the battery

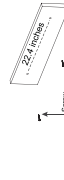
The battery for the remote control (1 CR2025 Lithium battery) is located on the back of the remote control. To install the battery, slide out the battery door on the remote control. Replace the battery with a new CR2025 battery with the positive (+) and negative (-) signs. Slide the battery door back to its original position.

NOTE: The AR2000 remote is packaged with a plastic protective tab extending out of the remote control's battery door.



Mounting the speaker

1. Measure a width of 22.4 inches on the wall.
2. Mark the position of the mounting screws on the wall using a pencil.
3. You may use a level to ensure the marks that you have made on the wall are approximately horizontal.
4. Put the Wireless Sound Bar onto the mounting screws. Make sure they are firm and stable.

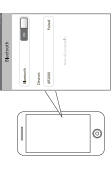
- Follow the instruction manual that came with your device.

Pairing the speaker with a Bluetooth enabled device

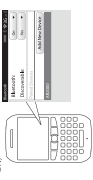
1. Turn the speaker ON.
2. Turn the speaker ON by pressing the [POWER] button on the speaker or remote control.
3. Press the [M] button on the speaker or remote control to enter Bluetooth Mode. A tone is heard and the Bluetooth LED indicator light will flash quickly.
4. Within three feet of each other during the pairing process.
5. Connect your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device to search for compatible Bluetooth devices.

NOTE: If there are no paired devices, pairing will not occur. If you are unable to pair, please refer to the Troubleshooting section of this manual.

- On an iPhone
- Go to SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



- On a BlackBerry
- Go to SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH
 - Enable BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



Playing music wirelessly

To enjoy listening to music wirelessly on your Wireless Speaker Bar, make sure you are connected to a device that supports Bluetooth. After playback starts, you can control the speaker from the Bluetooth-enabled device that has the AR2000 Bluetooth profile.

- Play/Pause**
- Quick press the [M] button on the speaker or the [M] key on the remote control to skip to the next song.

Speaker Stage

- Quick press the [VOL+/-] button on the speaker or the [VOL+/-] key on the remote control to skip to the next song.

Adjusting the volume

- Quick press the [VOL+/-] button on the speaker or the [VOL+/-] key on the remote control to increase the volume.
- Quick press the [VOL-] button on the speaker or the [VOL-] key on the remote control to decrease the volume.
- Press the [M] button on the remote control to mute the sound. Press again to turn the sound back on.

Using as a wired speaker

1. Turn the speaker ON.
2. Select ON or YES to pair the two units.
3. A tone will sound and the pairing process will begin. A solid, indicating that you are now connected.

NOTE: If you would like to connect the speaker to another device, you must disconnect the speaker device. Bluetooth settings, select "AR2000", then select "disconnect" or "unpair". When the speaker has been unpaired, repeat the pairing process.

Troubleshooting tips

1. If you cannot connect to your Bluetooth-enabled device:
 1. Make sure the Wireless Speaker Bar is turned ON.
 2. Keep the Wireless Speaker Bar and Bluetooth-enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
 3. Press the [MODE] button on the speaker or remote control to enter Bluetooth Mode. A tone is heard and the Bluetooth LED indicator light flashes blue quickly.
 4. Check that YOUR device's Bluetooth feature is turned ON.
 5. Try repeating the pairing process. Refer to "Pairing the Speaker with a Bluetooth Enabled Device."
2. If you cannot hear any music:
 1. Check that the speaker is turned ON.
 2. Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device.
 3. You may have to unpair the speaker, then re-pair it.
3. If you cannot hear any music from your Bluetooth-enabled device:
 1. Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile).
 2. Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device.
 3. You may have to unpair the speaker, then re-pair it.
