RE: PART 15 UNLICENSED MODULAR TRANSMITTER APPROVAL

To Whom It May Concern:

We, Kontron Europe GmbH, hereby requests for part 15 unlicensed modular transmitter approval of our device, described as follows:

Model name: HF-mPCIe
FCC ID: 2AATH-HFMPCIE

In FCC Public Notice DA 00-1407 released June 26,2000 there are eight numbered requirements that our device complies with:

1. The modular transmitter must have its own shielding.

The device complies with this requirement, refer to pictures of EuT.

2. The modular transmitter must have buffered modulation/data inputs

The device has USB-to-UART converter with internal buffer.

3. The modular transmitter must have its own power supply regulation

The device has its own power supply regulation. Please refer to schematics (IC1) and block diagram.

4. The modular transmitter must comply with the antenna requirements of Section 15.203 and 15.204c

The device is intended to be integrated in host equipenmt without access of the end user to the antenna and module.

5. The modular transmitter must be tested in a stand-alone configuration

The test was performed in a stand-alone configuration. Plese refer to test report and test setup pictures..

6. The modular transmitter must be labelled with its own FCC ID number

The device complies with this requirement, refer to sample of FCC label and picture were label will be placed on EuT.

7. The modular transmitter must comply with any specific rule or operating requirements applicable to the transmitter and the manufacturer must provide adequate instructions along with the module to explain any such requirements.

The module complies with the requirements of part 15.225, no additional requirements have to be met by the user.

8. The modular transmitter must comply with any applicable RF exposure requirements.

The module complies with this requirement, refer to RF exposure information (FCC).
