



Power ON/OFF & Reconnecting

To switch on, press and hold the MFB key until the blue indicator light blinks on and off. To switch off, press and hold the MFB key until the red indicator light blinks on and off. Adjust volume. Press and hold the + to increase and the - to decrease volume.

Next song, Momentarily press the +

Previous song, Momentarily press the -

Pause song, press the MFB key while music is playing.

Answer a Call

To answer and end a call Press the MFB key, or use the phone keys. (music will automatically pause durring phone calls) To reject a call Press and hold MFB key for 2 seconds, once the call is rejected

successfully, release the MFB key; or use the phone keys.

Redial the last dialed out number, Press the Multifunction button twice quickly.

Charging the battery

This device has an internal, rechargeable battery.

- 1. Connect the charger cable to the charging port on the left side of the headset. 2. Then connect the charger cable to a USB power source. The red indicator light will
- display during charging. If charging does not start, disconnect the charger, plug it in again, and retry. Charging the battery fully may take up to 3 hours.
- 3. When the battery is fully charged, the indicator light will turn blue and then turn off after 5 minutes. Disconnect the charger from the USB power source and the headset. The fully charged battery has power for up to 5 hours of talk-time, or up to 3 hours music time and up to 120 hours of standby time. However, the talk, music and standby times will vary from different devices, settings, and environments.

Pairing the headset with a compatible phone

- Make sure your headset is turned off.
- 2. Push the MFB key for about 3-5 seconds until the light flashes blue and red alternately.
- 3. Activate the Bluetooth® feature on the device, and set the device to search for Bluetooth® devices. The name of the Wireless Headset is BB896. See the user guide of your device for instructions.
- 4. If the pairing is successful, the headset's blue light will flash every 6 seconds.
- 5. If pass code is requested enter (0000) Once the headset has paired with your device, no password will be needed to reconnect
