3. System requirements

- 1. USB Port

4. Installation

- 1. Open the battery cover.
- 2. Insert the battery according to the markings in the batter compartment.
- 3. Connect the USB receiver to an available USB port on your PC.
- 4. The computer will detect and install the drivers automatically.
- 5. You can use the mouse now!
