





OPERATION

Plug the USB receiver into the USB port of the devices, such as computers, televisions, TV boxes. It takes about three seconds to install the drive automatically. The extended cable is for television connection, to ensure a more stable connection with the TV



FUNCTIONS OF TOUCHPAD

	One finger slides	Move the cursor.
	One finger clicks	Click at the place where the cursor stays
	Two fingers slide vertically. Two fingers slide horizontally.	The scrollbar slides vertically. The scrollbar slides horizontally.
	Two fingers move oppositely	Zoom in or zoom out the display area.
	3 fingers swipe up	Show Windows Menu
	3 fingers swipe down	Show Desktop
	3 fingers swipe left	Back
	3 fingers swipe right	Forward

The function that the scrollbar moves horizontally is only available for the

software supporting it, such as web, wps and etc.

CONSIDERATION:

If the keyboard fails to connect, you can try to connect again:

Insert the USB receiver into the USB port of the computer or the TV

Ensure that the keyboard is filled with 2 AAA batteries.

Press and hold ESC and k together until the red indicator light flashes and

it begins to connect. The distance between the receiver and the touchpad should

be within 20 cm. The keyboard starts to serve when the red indicator light stops

flashing and the connection is completed.
