



BATTERY INSTALLATION

Please insert battery as below:

- \Rightarrow Loosen the screw on the battery door (No. 1).
- ☆ Remove battery door.
- ☆ Insert battery with correct polarities (+/-) indicated (No. 2).
- ☆ Replace the battery door and tighten the screw.



OPEARATIONS

- ☆ Switch the unit on by turning ON/OFF swich.
- ☆ Push the talk switch for talking, release it for receiving.

CAUTIONS

Weak battery can leak and severely damage the unit. Always remove battery when the unit will not be used for a long time. Replace battery immediately when it becomes weak. This device complies with the part 15 of the FCC rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) this device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.
