Safety Precautions


Please read the manual thoroughly for safety precaution before using the product.

- Do not pull the power cable and unplug the product when it is not in use.

- When charging the mobile device, make sure to place it at the center of the front pad surface.

- When the charging is not working, check the status of adaptor and power plug connection. When the charging starts, green LED light will be on.

- During the charging, DMB use is not possible.





A/S service policy

- SNPowercom is providing the product warranty based on "Customers Dispute Settlement Standard" notified by Fair Trade Commission as follows:

- When the product is malfunctioning, please call the point of purchase or dial (070-4124-6110)

- Warranty decision will be made within 7 days of official request and applicable compensation will be made within 14 days of notification of the warranty decision.

- Any parts replaced for repair will be returned to the seller in order to prevent them from reuse in the future.

- Product warranty will be one(1) year from its purchase.

Free repair service

- Free repair service is provided during the warranty period, in case the product malfunctioning is caused during normal usage, barring the users' own faults

- In case the product is used for business purpose, the warranty period will be curtailed into 6 months from its purchase.
