

Charging the Battery

- **1.** Plug the charging cable into the DC outlet of the white noise machine.
- 2. Plug the USB cable into a DC 5V adapter and plug into an outlet. You can also plug the cable into a powered USB port. will appear on the display.
- **3.** When the machine is fully charged, will disappear.

Note:

- The charging time is about 4-5 hours.
- We recommend fully charging your white noise machine before use.

Low-Battery Indicator

will flash on the display when it is time to charge the battery.

Operation

Turn the Machine On/Off

- Press to turn the machine on and off.
- The machine will automatically turn off after an hour of inactivity.

Turn the LED Display On/Off

- Press and hold 0 for 2 seconds to turn off the LED display.
- Press any button to turn the display back on.

Set the Clock

- **1.** Press and hold **1.** until the hour flashes on the display.
- 2. Press | or | to adjust the hour.
- **3.** Press **7** again. The minutes will flash.
- **4.** Press | or | to adjust the minutes.
- **5.** Press **1** to set the clock.

Connect to a Bluetooth Device

- **1.** Press \bigcirc to turn on the machine.
- **2.** Press \$ to enter Bluetooth mode.

Note: This will disable white noise playback until Bluetooth is turned off.

- **3.** * will flash on the display, indicating that the machine is ready to pair.
- 4. In your mobile device's Bluetooth settings, select Etekcity EWN-12. If pairing is successful, * will turn solid.

Note: Press * again to exit Bluetooth mode.

To pair with another Bluetooth device:

- Unpair the machine by pressing and holding *.
- 2. * will flash on the display, indicating that the machine is ready to be paired again.
- 3. Follow the steps in Connect to a Bluetooth Device.

Play Music via the Bluetooth Speaker

- **1.** Press () to turn the machine on.
- 2. Press * to turn Bluetooth on.

Note:

- This will disable white noise playback until Bluetooth is turned off.
- If you have not yet paired a mobile device with the white noise machine, see Connect to a Bluetooth Device (page 11).
- 3. Press ►II to play or pause music from your mobile device.
- **4.** Press | or | to adjust the volume.
- 5. Press and hold or □ to cycle through music.

Play White Noise

- **1.** Press **(b)** to turn the machine on.
- 2. Press II to play or pause the white noise.
- **3.** Press **I** or **▶** I to adjust the volume.
- **4.** Press and hold or or to cycle through the 18 white noise tracks.

Set the Timer

- **1.** Press \bigcirc to turn the machine on.
- **2.** Press **1** to set the timer.

Note: Timer can be set for 30 min, 60 min, 90 min, 2 hr, or 7 hr.

- **3.** Will appear on the display. The selected time will flash for 5 seconds, then return to the current time.
- **4.** The selected white noise track will begin to play and automatically stops playing when the sleep time expires.

Note:

- Will remain on the display while the timer is on.
- The timer will only work while the machine is playing white noise. The timer does not work in Bluetooth mode.
- Press while the timer is on to see the remaining time. Press again to adjust the timer.
